


American Wood Turners Show – San Jose

Five members of CVWA attended the annual symposium of the American Assn. of Woodturners in San Jose, California. Those in attendance were Stephen Case-Pall, Joel Oksner, Paul Brockway, Tim Albers, and John Knittle. The symposium is a gathering of teachers, demonstrators, and turners from all over the world. It is held in alternate years on the east and west coasts. It offered literally hundreds of "rotations", which are live demonstrations from experts in the field. Some of the teaching demonstrations included inlaying and turning pewter into your wood, spiral turning, wood inlay, carving and texturing, concepts of design and form, platters, hollow form techniques, segmented forms, photography, multiple axis turning, natural edge bowls, turning with a strobe, duplication, thin walled goblets, marquetry and dozens more. There was also a trade show where one could buy the latest gadgets for turning. Tim and I were sufficiently impressed with the new CBN all-steel grinding wheels to bring them home. They are better and longer lasting than diamond wheels, and theoretically should last a lifetime, at least mine, if not Tim's. There was also an opportunity to hand-pick from many rare or exotic woods, which we all did. The State of California had a booth assisting wood turners in bringing home woods that do not have pests or damaging insects in them. Species which have no natural enemies are devastating wood growth as they are transported to new areas. For everyone's delight, there was a large "instant gallery" of turned wood by the nation's finest turners, and amateurs.
