January's Speaker: Thank You Juan Hovey!

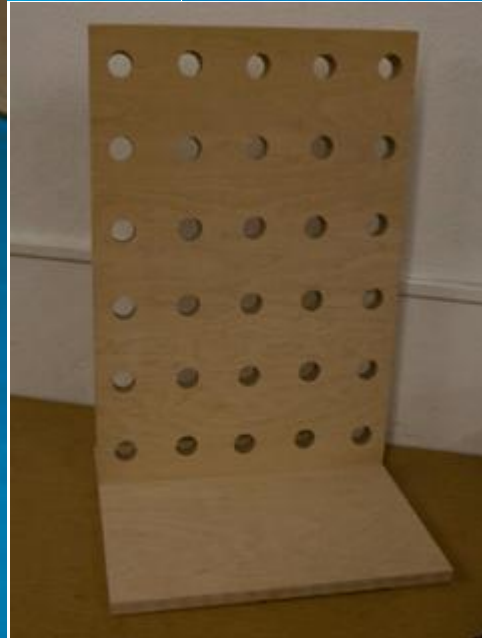

Juan demonstrated the process of cutting out, peening, shaping the metal sides of the planes. Also, the in-fill wooden frog and knob designs and the brass adjustment screw and blade clamp. Juan provided the details of what goes into one of the tools we all use regularly and demonstrated that it is possible for us woodworkers to create our own tools, if we so desired.



Below are some of the tools and parts to create an In-fill plane.

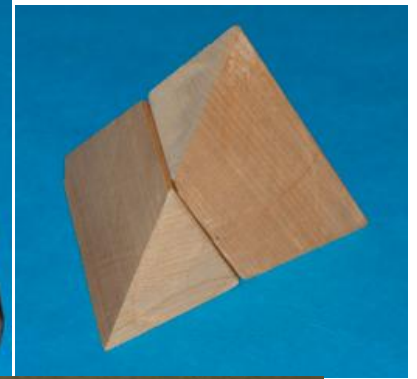
