

# UNIFORM JUNIORS - Contemporary

## WHAT IT CONSISTS OF

BB Baseball Cap, BB Navy Polo Shirt, Section Crest Juniors, Navy Shorts, Armband, Company Title x1, BB Socks, and Black Shoes

## WEARING THE JUNIORS UNIFORM

**BB Baseball Cap**– fits snugly on the head by adjusting the velcro

**BB Navy Polo Shirt** – should be clean and tucked into the shorts

**Section Crest** – sewn centrally under the logo along the red stitched line

**Armband** - worn on the right arm with your company title at the very top. Badges should be placed in the following order when achieved:

*Top Row: Anchor highest achieved triangle / Bronze or Silver Service x 3 (Service awards – NOTE: the 4<sup>th</sup> year service award is issued in the form of a metal badge once they move into seniors)*

*Middle Row: Yellow / Pink / White / Green (Achievement awards)*

*Bottom Row: Purple / Blue / Red / Gold (Achievement awards)*

**Company Title** – sewn centrally on the top of the armband (obtained from your company directly)

**Shorts Navy** – plain elastic waisted shorts should be clean and neatly pressed. Plain navy - no logos or brands

**BB Socks** - Brigade navy blue long socks are to be fully drawn up to just below the knees with tops turned over to show white bands.

**Shoes** - black, clean and laces tied neatly. Leather shoes should be polished



# UNIFORM JUNIORS - Classic

## WHAT IT CONSISTS OF

BB Cap, Cap Badge, BB Navy Shirt, Blue Tie, Battalion Crest, Section Crest, Navy Shorts, Armband, Shoulder Title x2, BB Socks, and Black Shoes

## WEARING THE JUNIORS UNIFORM

**BB Cap**– fits snugly on the head. The cloth badge is sewn on the top left side of the cap, 5cm from the front.

**BB Navy Shirt** – should be clean, ironed and tucked into the shorts

**Shoulder Titles** – sewn centrally on both sleeves, 5cm down from the shoulder seam (obtained from your company directly)

**Battalion Crest** – sewn centrally on the right pocket

**Section Crest** – sewn centrally on the left pocket

**Blue Tie** – should be clean, ironed

**Armband** - worn on the right arm. Badges should be placed in the following order when achieved:

*Top Row: Anchor highest achieved triangle/ Bronze or Silver Service x 3 (Service awards – NOTE: the 4<sup>th</sup> year service award is issued in the form of a metal badge once they move into seniors)*

*Middle Row: Yellow / Pink / White / Green (Achievement awards)*

*Bottom Row: Purple / Blue / Red / Gold (Achievement awards)*

**Shorts Navy** – plain elastic waisted shorts should be clean and neatly pressed. Plain navy - no logos or brands

**BB Socks** - Brigade navy blue long socks are to be fully drawn up to just below the knees with tops turned over to show white bands.
