

Universal Technical Institute MSAT Relocation Grant 2024-2025

Grant Information Sheet

Objective:

To provide grants for housing costs incurred through Collegiate Housing Services or Compass Rose Housing for students currently attending, or previously graduated from Universal Technical Institute or NASCAR Technical Institute who need to relocate to another Universal Technical Institute campus in order to complete a Manufacturer Specific Advanced Training Program (MSAT) in order to further their education. Eligible MSAT programs are listed below. This grant will support enrolled relocating students who meet the criteria outlined below. This grant is only available for housing secured through Collegiate Housing Services or Compass Rose Housing and will cover the applicant's service fee(deposit) (if applicable) and rent for the Core, Compact or Moderate (per Housing Provider) shared housing unit for the duration of the program, not to exceed 15 weeks (new attempt of courses only). The MSAT Relocation Grant will not be extended due to course failures. If a student chooses or accepts to reside in a higher tier housing level than the core or moderate levels, the student is responsible for paying the difference in the monthly rent. Student is responsible for the Application Fee charged through Collegiate Housing Services (\$25) or Compass Rose Housing (\$50).

Criteria for awarding grant:

This Grant in Aid is available to applicants who previously attended, are currently attending, or scheduled to attend a Universal Technical Institute campus or NASCAR Technical Institute and have a desire to further their education by enrolling in one of the specified MSAT programs listed below that are not offered at their initial campus location*. Eligible applicants must be required to relocate in order to attend the manufacturer specific program, in addition to the eligibility requirements listed below to be eligible to apply:

Students must:

- Be currently enrolled or a graduate from one of the Universal Technical Institute campuses, or NASCAR Technical Institute.
- Students must graduate with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and meet all enrollment requirements of the manufacturer specific advanced training program that they are enrolling into.
- Enrolled to begin one of the MSAT programs listed below at a separate Universal Technical Institute campus or NASCAR Technical Institute location from initial enrolled campus, no later than September 30, 2025
 - o BMW Fast Track program (only Available at Orlando, FL; Avondale, AZ; Exton, PA; Lisle, IL; Houston, TX; Long Beach, CA campuses).
 - Cummins Engines Program
 - o Cummins Power Generation program
 - o DTNA Finish First program
 - o Ford FACT program
 - o Toyota TPAT program
 - o General Motors Technician Training program
 - o MOPAR TEC Training program
- Be eligible for (and utilize) housing through Collegiate Housing Services or Compass Rose Housing during their MSAT program enrollment.

Process and Rules:

Information about this grant is posted on the UTI website at: www.uti.edu/scholarships. The Universal Technical Institute MSAT Relocation Grant is only available for students who require relocation for an MSAT program that is not currently offered at their existing campus. Exceptions to this rule will only be made for MSAT programs (located at student's existing campus) that are at full capacity and can no longer take new students. This grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI scholarship, grant, or tuition reduction program during enrollment to the Manufacturer Specific Training Program (i.e., Industry's Choice Scholarship, Salute to Service Grant, Elective Scholarship). Applicants will need to complete an application and submit it to the UTI Scholarship Department. Applications will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this grant. This grant is paid directly to Collegiate Housing Services and Compass Rose Housing and is applied towards the student's housing costs.

If a student fails to graduate, does not meet the enrollment requirements for their MSAT program or changes start date or campus, their grant may be forfeited. Any grants awarded are not transferable to any other person. If a student chooses not to attend the Manufacturer Specific Training Program or after beginning their MSAT program chooses to leave for any reason (withdrawal, suspended, terminated), they will forfeit the Universal Technical Institute MSAT Relocation Grant immediately and will be responsible for any remaining costs incurred through Collegiate Housing Services or Compass Rose Housing. If the student fails one of the MSAT courses, the grant will not cover the MSAT failure course time frame for rent due or a subsequent Leave of Absence that is incurred if the MSAT course is not available after the failed course.

Grants shall not be used as a recruiting device. Funding for this program is limited and the program may be suspended at any time at UTI's discretion. Such a suspension will not affect awards to students who are awarded a grant under this program prior to the suspension date.

This Universal Technical Institute MSAT Relocation Grant is provided to students who are currently enrolled in a program, or previously graduated from a program at Universal Technical Institute or NASCAR Technical Institute, who desire to further their education by enrolling in one of the MSAT programs listed above that are not offered at their initial campus location*.

Enrolled students are automatically reviewed for eligibility. The Universal Technical Institute MSAT Relocation Grant Application Form must be completed and submitted to your Student Development Advisor prior to starting classes in your MSAT Program.

The Universal Technical Institute MSAT Relocation Grant will only be available for students utilizing Collegiate Housing Services or Compass Rose Housing and will cover the applicant's Service Fee (deposit) (if applicable) and rent for the Compass Rose (Compact or Core) or CHS (Moderate) shared housing unit for the duration of the program, not to exceed 15 weeks. UTI will pay these funds directly to Collegiate Housing Services or Compass Rose Housing. Student is responsible for the Application Fee.

This grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI Scholarship, grant, or tuition reduction that UTI, Inc. offers during the enrollment to the Manufacturer Specific Training Program (such as the Industry's Choice Scholarship, Salute to Service Grant or Elective Scholarship). *MSAT Relocation Grants may be approved for two MSAT programs and will be reviewed on an individual basis.

If a student fails to graduate, does not meet the enrollment requirements for their MSAT program or changes start date or campus, his/her grant may be forfeited. Any grants awarded are not transferable to any other person. If a student chooses not to attend their Manufacturer Specific Training Program or after beginning their MSAT program chooses to leave for any reason (withdrawal, suspended, terminated), they will forfeit the Universal Technical Institute MSAT Relocation Grant immediately and will be responsible for any remaining costs incurred through Collegiate Housing Services or Compass Rose Housing. If the student fails one of the MSAT courses, the grant will not cover the MSAT failure course time frame for rent due or a subsequent Leave of Absence that is incurred if the MSAT course is not available after the failed course.
