

2024-2025 NASCAR PERFORMANCE TECHNICIAN OF TOMORROW GRANT PROGRAM NASCAR Technical Institute Grant Amount: \$2,500

Objective:

NASCAR is looking for the perfect blend of technical skills and attitude, just like every employer of NASCAR Technical Institute's graduates. This program seeks to assist students who are looking for great career training with NASCAR Technical Institute, and who truly understand and exhibit the traits of a great team member.

Criteria for awarding the grant:

This grant program is available for enrolled students who meet all other admissions requirements for NASCAR Technical Institute. In addition, all applicants must meet all of the criteria outlined below to be eligible to apply.

Eligibility Details:

- Student must be enrolled to begin training in a start date listed below at NASCAR Technical Institute.
- Submit the NASCAR Performance Technician of Tomorrow Grant application prior to starting classes.
- Students receiving the following scholarships/grants are not eligible to receive the NASCAR Performance Technician of Tomorrow Grant:
 - NASCAR Performance Diversity Initiative Grant
 - Salute to Service Grant
 - Industry's Choice Scholarship

If a student is eligible for any of the programs listed above at the time of application review, their NASCAR Performance Technician of Tomorrow Grant application will be deemed ineligible.

Process and Rules: This grant program is available starting January 15, 2025, through September 30, 2025. Students must complete an application and Essay and submit them both to the UTI Scholarships & Grants Department. For all applicants, the final deadline for receipt of this application is the day before their scheduled start date. All eligible applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarships & Grants Committee, and all applicants will be notified of the grant outcome. Up to two (2) eligible applicants will be awarded for each eligible start date. This grant is ONLY available to incoming students who are enrolled to attend the NASCAR Technical Institute campus. Students already attending classes are ineligible to apply.

<u>Program Disclaimers:</u> The applications received will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. All incoming applications will be reviewed for eligibility. Students who apply and meet all eligibility requirements will be considered for this grant. Only one (1) award of this grant will be given per student.

The NASCAR Performance Technician of Tomorrow Grant is evaluated and awarded using a multi-step review process and eligibility is identified using a predefined grading matrix. Of those viable applications, the awards will be distributed to those students who most clearly and adequately answer the essay questions provided: "What are the skills and personality traits needed to make a great NASCAR team? How do you exhibit those traits? How would this grant help you to develop those skills and traits for a successful career as a technician?" All viable applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarships & Grants Committee. Students must be enrolled to attend NASCAR Technical Institute at the time of the application submission. Grants awarded are not transferable to any other person. This grant is considered an internal tuition reduction and has no cash value. All internal tuition reductions are pro-rated over the time a student is in school. If a student chooses not to attend NASCAR Technical Institute prior to the deadline or, after beginning their program chooses to leave for any reason (withdrawal, suspended, terminated), they will forfeit any unused portion of the award. All grants awarded through this program can only be used during the initial enrollment, any unutilized funds cannot be applied to a secondary account/enrollment.
