



2026 Phoenix Union High School District Spring Scholarship Program

Universal Technical Institute
Scholarship Amount: \$5,000

Objective:

To provide tuition assistance to students who seek to enroll at Universal Technical Institute. This scholarship program is aimed at students who reflect a true commitment to converting their talents working with their hands into a career as a professional in the trades industry.

Criteria for awarding the scholarship:

This scholarship program is available to all students who are currently enrolled and set to graduate from a high school located within the Phoenix Union High School District during the 2025-2026 academic year. All applicants must meet all other admissions requirements for Universal Technical Institute, in addition to all of the criteria outlined below, to be eligible to apply.

Students must:

- Be enrolled to start UTI (with the exception of the Exton, PA campus).
- Be able to show proof that they are currently enrolled and set to graduate from a high school located within the Phoenix Union High School District during the 2025-2026 academic year.
- Provide the name, organization, and contact information of someone who can speak to your professional character.
- Answer the essay questions listed in the application.
- Must redeem scholarship and start classes no later than one (1) year after high school graduation.

Process and Rules: This scholarship program is available starting January 1, 2026, through April 30, 2026. Students must complete an application and essay and submit both to the UTI Scholarships & Grants Department. For all applicants, the deadline for receipt of the application by the Scholarships & Grants Department is **Thursday, April 30, 2026**. All eligible applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarships & Grants Committee, and ten (10) applicants will be awarded no later than **Monday, May 11, 2026**. **This scholarship is ONLY available to incoming students who attended high school in the Phoenix Union High School District. Students already attending classes at UTI are ineligible to apply.** The Phoenix Union High School District Scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with the UTI Academic Excellence Grant. Students who are eligible for both awards will receive the highest value scholarship or grant.

Application submission options:

- a) Scholarship Universe www.uti.scholarshipuniverse.com – If you have not done so already, you will need to create an account with Scholarship Universe. This can easily be done using your UTI student email. Once your account has been created you will be prompted to start answering general questions that will automatically match you to scholarship programs that you are eligible to apply for.
- b) Email scholarships@uti.edu – You can submit a completed application via email directly to the UTI Scholarships & Grants Department
- c) Fax (623) 445-0793 - You can submit a completed application via fax directly to the UTI Scholarships & Grants Department

Only one award of this scholarship will be given per student. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this scholarship. Of those viable applications, the awards will be distributed to those students who most clearly express commitment to success as a professional in the trades industry through the essay questions asked in the application. All viable applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarships & Grants Committee. Students must be enrolled to attend Universal Technical Institute at the time of application submission*. Scholarships awarded are not transferable to any other person. This scholarship is considered an internal tuition reduction and has no cash value. All internal tuition reductions are pro-rated over the time a student is in school. If a student chooses not to attend UTI prior to the deadline or, after beginning their program chooses to leave for any reason (withdrawal, suspended, terminated), they will forfeit any unused portion of the award. All scholarships granted through this program can only be used during the initial enrollment; any unutilized funds cannot be applied to a secondary account/enrollment.
