

Your cost of attendance (COA) is an estimate of the expenses you may incur while attending Universal Technical Institute (UTI). The COA includes direct expenses such as tuition, fees, books, course materials, supplies, and equipment. Indirect expenses such as living expenses, including food and housing, transportation, and other personal miscellaneous expenses. In conjunction with the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and/or other agencies, UTI uses the cost of attendance budgets to help determine a student's eligibility for financial aid.

Costs vary by campus, program, and are subject to change without notice. UTI's catalog addendum lists the current tuition at each campus. All expenses are based off a 12-month academic year and should be adjusted if you have less than a year remaining in your program. The Cost of Attendance budget outlined below shows the average expenses per student and reported on the College Board.
