

UNIVERSAL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE – ORLANDO GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

ELIGIBLE DATES: VALID FOR JANUARY 5, 2026, START DATE

Unlike a loan, a grant does not have to be repaid. The Institutional Grant and Relocation Grant are designed to assist students who have the greatest financial need. The grant amount is based on financial need. The maximum can change each award year and depends on program funding.

10% INSTITUTIONAL GRANT

This grant is to assist students who are in the greatest financial need and are relocating or commuting 50 miles or greater to attend UTI by reducing their overall tuition.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Relocating or commuting 50 or more miles daily to campus*

EXCLUSIONS

- Students receiving the Relocation Grant
- Students receiving the Salute to Service Grant
- Students receiving the Technical Education Institutional Grant
- Students receiving any other UTI-funded, need-based scholarship, grant or tuition reduction
- Laptop, Lab Fee and Meter Fee coverage

RELOCATION GRANT

This grant is to assist students who are in the greatest financial need and are relocating or commuting 50 miles or greater to attend UTI by subsidizing costs associated with relocation, housing or making long commutes back and forth to school. The grant allows students to focus on academics and gaining local employment, helping set them up for long-term success.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Relocating or commuting 50 or more miles daily to campus*

EXCLUSIONS

- Students receiving the Institutional Grant
- Students receiving the Salute to Service Grant
- Students receiving the Technical Education Institutional Grant
- Students receiving any other UTI-funded, need-based scholarship, grant or tuition reduction
- Laptop, Lab Fee and Meter Fee coverage
