Eligible Students will receive a 10% tuition grant for all automotive, diesel, motorcycle, and marine UTI programs or a 5% tuition grant for all other UTI programs.

If a student completes the form while actively attending a qualifying program and does not receive a passing grade, the student is required to email (scholarships@uti.edu), prior to starting at UTI, to have the grant removed.

Students must be enrolled to attend Universal Technical Institute at the time of application submission. Grants awarded are not transferable to any other person. Only one (1) award of this grant will be given per student. This grant is considered an internal tuition reduction and has no cash value. All internal tuition reductions are pro-rated over the time a student is in school. If a student chooses not to attend UTI prior to the deadline or, after beginning their program chooses to leave for any reason (withdrawal, suspended, terminated), they will forfeit any unused portion of the award. All grants awarded through this program can only be used during the initial enrollment; any unutilized funds cannot be applied to a secondary account/enrollment.
