Vital Statistics – May 2024

In May of 2024, there were 12 graduates of TEDS' MA in Mental Health Counseling program. Our graduates consistently achieve high pass rates on licensing examinations. The pass rate for graduates taking the NCE examination in the spring of 2024 was 100%.

During the 2023-24 academic year, there were 58 students enrolled in the mental health counseling program at TEDS. Of that number, there were 47 females and 11 males; 50% identified as White and 50% as People of Color. While our program accommodates both part-time and full-time students, approximately 75% of our students graduate in the projected time: three years for full-time students.

Graduates of our MA in MHC go on to work in a variety of settings, such as private practices, social service agencies, hospitals, and college counseling centers. Some of our graduates move directly into doctoral programs; others defer the job search due to other career opportunities, geographical moves, and/or responsibilities related to family life. Of the students who actively seek employment upon completion of the program, 95% of them secure positions in the field of mental healthcare within 3 months of graduation.
