SDP Chieftains Worried Over State of Nation

Chief Olu Falae and other chieftains of the Social Democratic Party (SDP) such as former Minister of Education, Prof. Tunde Adeniran, and the National Chairman of the SDP, have all called to question the poor state of the nation's affairs, especially the economy and insecurity. They spoke in Abuja at the official opening of the party's new Secretariat. Falae, a former national chairman of the party spoke with emphasis on the insecurity that has engulfed the entire country unlike in the past. He recalled his kidnap experience at the age of 77 at his farm, saying that all hands must be on deck to rescue the country. He said: "Nigeria today is in crisis. And vou cannot move from one town today to another without the fear of being kidnapped. "I, myself was kidnapped for four days, seven years ago in my farm. When I was a child, I travelled from Akure to attend school by myself. No kidnapper, no problem. "At 77 years old, I was kidnapped. That tells you the dramatic decline in Nigeria. Only a party properly structured can change it. Not this so called big parties. "When I say they are not parties, they say they control the federal government, state governments. Use Nigerian Architects For Sensitive Security Buildings: NIA Tells Government

he Nigerian Institute of Architects (NIA) has advised governments at both federal and state to stop using foreign architects to design sensitive security buildings.

The First Vice President of the institute and chairman ARCHIBUILT Exposition 2022 committee, Mobilaji Adeniyi gave the advise on Wednesday at the ongoing ARCHIBUILT Exposition 2022 taking place in Abuja from 5-7 of October.

Adeniyi said government should stop giving the design of sensitive security buildings to foreign architects rather they should be given to Nigerian professionals

She said, "though govt is patronising Nigerian architects and local building materials, but they have to do more. Because they now have the local content policy which means govt should be patronising its professionals.

"Before that we have been advocating; we have we have a lot of incursion if foreign professionals on our turf, many of our iconic buildings in Nigeria are designed by expertrates engineers which ought not to be so." She added

She called on the government to open up the architectural sector for competition to allow Nigerian professionals to compete with the foreign professionals who are brought in to design major and iconic buildings. "If govt is putting so much in training professionals; it should be using its professionals. We looking forward to competitions where major and iconic buildings will be thrown open to the Nigerian architects to show our expertise. So we don't always have to bring in foreign architects. Particularly buildings that have sensitive security issues; we make sure that it's our own professionals that are designing them."

The president of NIA, Envi Ben-Eboh, said the exhibition intended to show case local building materials.







- He was the first gubernatorial candidate in Nigeria to legally challenge to its logical conclusion, his governorship electoral victory that was denied him. He won in
- the Courts and reclaimed his mandate. He was the first Governor in Nigeria to legally challenge his wrongful impeachment and was reinstated by the Courts.
- He was the first Governor in Nigeria to seek the interpretation of tenures of Governors when INEC allowed elections to take place in Anambra State when his tenure had not expired; the election already concluded was cancelled and he was allowed to complete his tenure.
- He was the first Governor to serve a 2nd term in both the new and old Anambra State, that is, almost 40 years after creation of the State.
- He was the first Governor, whilst still in Office, to be appointed a Special Adviser to the President.
- He was the first serving Governor to be appointed into the Presidential Economic Management Team.
- He was among the first Governors to be honoured with a National Award in 2011, while still in office.
- Though the only Governor whose political party was in government in only one State, he was elected Vice-Chairman of the Nigeria Governors' Forum twice.
 Though the only non-PDP Governor in the South-East (made up of 5 States), he was elected by the other 4 PDP Governors as their Chairman for 8 years rather than the usual one year.

FUNDAMENTAL ACHIEVEMENTS AS Governor of Anambra State (Partial Listing)

1. Anambra was the first State to commence Sub-Sovereign Wealth savings, the first of its kind in Sub-Saharan Africa. At a time many other Governors were leaving huge debts, I left the equivalent of \$500 million Dollars in investment as well

as local and foreign currency, including \$156 million in Dollar-denominated bonds.

2. For the first time in the history of Anambra State, Ambassadors and High Commissioners of notable countries such as United Stated, Britain, Russia, European Union, South Africa, Belgium, Israel, the Netherlands, Canada, among others, visited the State. Before my tenure, Anambra was practically a pariah state blacklisted by the Diplomatic Corps and international development partners.

3. Development partners such as UNDP, UNICEF, the World Bank, DFID, the European Union etc., which hitherto were not in Anambra State started working with the State. Anambra was consistently adjudged one of the best states in development partnership and commitment to reforms for good governance.

4. He was recognised as Best Governor by the Millennium Development Goals Office (OSSAP-MDGs) and the UNDP in the implementation of their programmes in Nigeria.

5. The Nigerian Debt Management Office (DMO) rated Anambra as the least indebted state in Nigeria. In spite of visible and measurable achievements recorded in various sectors, the State under him did not borrow or raise bonds for her various projects.

6. The Senate of the Federal Republic of Nigeria rated Anambra State as the most financially stable state in the country.

7. The State's ground-breaking return of schools to their original owners -Voluntary Agencies (Churches) on 1st January 2009, and subsequent partnership with the Agencies in Education, saw the State move from 24th position out of 36 States to Number One in National Examination Council (NECO) and West African Examination Council (WAEC) examinations for three consecutive years. This made the World Bank to commission a study, led by the renowned Prof. Paul Collier of Oxford University, on this revolutionary partnership and phenomenal achievement.

8. The State also entered into strategic partnership with the Churches in the Health sector. This symbiotic relationship resulted in a tremendous boost to health care because of the services offered by health institutions owned by Voluntary Agencies, while the State restored grants to the agencies and made available to them more than 50 million Dollars in various types of support.

9. Through partnership with the Church in the Health sector, his Government funded the transformation of -:

a: Iyienu Hospital, Ogidi; b: Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital, Ihiala;

c: St Charles Borromeo Hospital, Onitsha; d: Holy Rosary Hospital, Waterside, Onitsha; and e: St. Joseph Hospital, Adazi-Nnukwu. His Government also built the Joseph Nwilo Heart Centre in St. Joseph, Adazi-Nnukwu,

where heart operations are now being performed.10. His Government won the Bill and Melinda Gates

Foundation (1 Million dollars) as the best-performing state in immunisation in the South-East. With complementary funding from our Government, they used the money to build 10 Maternal and Child Care Centres across the State, particularly in rural communities, in partnership with the Churches.

11. The State was the first to procure and distribute more than 30,000 computers to secondary schools, including 22,500 from HP. The Managing Director for Personal Systems Group HP Inc, Mr. FabriceCampoy described the deployment as the biggest of such projects in the Middle-East and Africa.

12. Anambra State Government provided Microsoft Academies to more than 500 secondary schools, which the Head of Microsoft in Nigeria (Mr. Ken Span) described as the biggest such deployment in Africa so far.

13. The State provided Internet access to more than 500 secondary schools, which the CEO of Galaxy Backbone (Mr. Gerald Ilukwe) characterized as incomparable to any in the country.

14. More than 700 buses were provided to secondary schools in the State by our Government.

15. Boreholes were provided in schools all over the State.

16. Numerous classrooms were built in all the 177 communities of the State.

17 As part of the efforts to turn around the economy of the State, a number of companies were attracted to build their facilities in the Anambra State. A case in point is SABMiller, the 2nd largest brewery in the world, which built their first Green Field facility in the State, which is today one of the most successful facilities they operate globally.

18. A number of other companies followed the SABMiller initiative and were all supported and encouraged under our Government; a good example is INNOSON Motor Manufacturing Company, from which our government bought more than 1,000 vehicles.

19. Anambra State for the first



time started close collaboration with recognized government security agencies (the Police, Army, Navy, Department of State Security, Civil Defence, among others), offering them various types of support including provision of more than 500 security vehicles. The improvement in security was phenomenal, such that the former IG of Police (Abubakar Mohammed) lauded Anambra State for not witnessing any bank robbery in my last three years in office.

20. To further enhance security, Anambra State provided at least one security vehicle to each of all the 177 communities in the State as well as various organizations such as markets and Churches.

21. His Administration conceived and built, from

scratch, the first stateowned Teaching Hospital, Chukwuemeka Odumegwu-Ojukwu teaching Hospital, Awka.

22. His Government commenced the planned development of the Igbariam Campus of the ChukwuemekaOdumegwu-Ojukwu University, including the fencing, construction of internal roads, electrification, construction of the Faculty of Law, Auditorium, Administrative Block, Faculty of Agriculture, Management Building, among others).

23. His Government attracted the World Bank support on erosion - National Erosion and Watershed Management Project (NEWMAP) - to Anambra State. **24.** His Government was the first to do Poverty Mapping in Nigeria, as a guide for the effective implementation of our poverty-alleviation strategies.

25. His Government, for the first time, undertook the aerial mapping of Awka as well as the production of Structure Plans for Awka Capital Territory, Onitsha and Nnewi.

26. During his tenure and with his Government's support, Anambra State became an oil producing State.

27. He built the first Secretariat Complex to house State Government Ministries that were hitherto scattered around the State.

28. His government commenced the development of the 'Three Arms Zone' comprising

Government House/Governor's Lodge, Legislative Building/ Speakers Residence, and Judiciary Building with Chief Judge's Residence.

29. By the end of his tenure in 2014, more than twelve (12) health institutions, including two hospitals, had secured accreditation; when we took off in 2006, no health institution in Anambra State was duly accredited.

30. Anambra State was the first to undergo national peer review, which scrutinised State Governments for good governance, through the State Peer Review Mechanism (SPRM), an initiative of the Nigerian Governors' Forum in collaboration with the DFID.

How do you see yourself making a difference in Nigeria?

We will offer a new brand of transformative and purposeful leadership. Nigeria is not bereft of good governance ideas and plans. However, a combination of institutional weaknesses and lack of political will, meant that various policies and strategies are poorly implemented leading to poor outcomes for the people. Hence, the overall goal of my administration shall be to streamline governance, make it more responsive, transformative, effective, less transactional, and therefore efficient and costeffective.

What kind of leadership do you hope to provide **Nigerians?**

Thinking through 2023 and beyond, we must think seriously about a leadership that is imbued with competence, capacity, credibility and commitment. Accordingly, we will pursue intangible assets of good governance, rule of law, security of lives and properties; we will ensure that we have these assets in place and stress asset optimization.

Africa has looked to Nigeria for leadership but has found it absent and wanting. What would you do to restore leadership?

Our foreign policy has always been Afrocentric. So, Africa will remain the centrepiece of our foreign policy. We will strike a strategic balance that allows us to promote and protect national interest, while meeting our ECOWAS obligations. We will rebuild Nigeria's military power, promote economic growth, and enhance its technological prowess with a view to improving Nigeria's diplomatic influence in sub-regional, regional and global affairs.

Restoring leadership will require that we reassert proactively, Nigeria's leadership role in African affairs through constructive engagement, peacekeeping duties, and using existing sub-regional and regional forums as well as bilateral platforms for dialogue on current and emerging challenges. Regional Security

Foreign and National Security policy initiatives, might in the long term entail rebuilding, repositioning and sustaining ECOMOG, as the arrowhead of a West African Security partnership. This is to counter terrorist threats and international subversion of the sovereignty of the West African region of which Nigeria must reestablish her place as a regional power.

Will you be maintaining the policy of fixed exchange rates coupled with heavy government borrowing? Will you be adhering to the fiscal responsibility laws?

We will abide by the fiscal responsibility laws. Despite the exigency and convenience which the two-tier foreign exchange regime offers, it has become an albatross. Hence that arrangement will be critically reviewed, adjusted or even eliminated. We will explore ways of cushioning the forex demands by mainstreaming those components of Diaspora remittances that remain opaque and informal. With proper policy and planning, we can expect to boost and leapfrog the current \$20 billion in remittances to \$40b to \$60b annually. That will translate to about 14% of our total GDP.

The youth have often felt left out in the country especially in the light of central Bank policies on tech companies. Will you reconsider these policies? How do you propose to address the brain drain?

We are challenged by high youth unemployment, which stands at 33.3%; 54% for the youth; and 20 million out-of-schoolchildren. We must give this country back to the Nigerian youths. Half of our 200 million people are below the age of 30.

Harnessing our national youth strength and demographic dividends intelligently, must start with curbing the high youth unemployment and creating funding access to enable our youths become entrepreneurs and drivers of our Small and Medium Scale enterprises (SMEs).

We will work to bring down the unemployment rate to fewer than 20 percent over the next four years, if elected. Part of our objectives on the economy will be focused on supporting job creation given its impact on the economy as well as poverty alleviation.

We will review the legislation guiding the fund access modalities to Universal Basic Education Commission (UBEC), and the Tertiary Education Trust Fund (TETFund), to transparency, and ensure increased flexibility, to meet the educational need of the Nigerian students they are meant to serve.

We will explore ways and means of tapping in on technology transfer from the Diaspora; we will also explore ways of reversing debilitating for our country. We will trigger every known technological and knowledge transfer initiators. Nigeria's brain drain will be turned into brain gain.

Will the corrupt be allowed to keep their loot? How much focus will be given to probes?

We will have zero-tolerance for corruption; block leakages and cut the cost of governance. Our total commitment to transparency and accountability in government business is the only credible way to achieve limited to zero corruption.

The policies required to fight corruption already exist; it is the political will to implement them that has been lacking. My governance modalities have always been forward looking and will remain so. We will negotiate the return of our stolen national wealth from the custodial countries.

Will you be maintaining the subsidies on electricity and petroleum?

There are two elements of subsidy- the corruption component and the real subsidy component. The oil subsidy arrangement as it stands is fraught with criminality. It is unacceptable.

For the corruption, we will deal with decisively which will reduce the subsidy cost by over 50%. There will be weighted measures and counterbalance policies and programmes to cushion the impact of the removal of oil subsidy, if and when it is removed. The difference is that now, only some sacred and self-entitled few benefit from the oil subsidy. That narrative will change.

We will support local refining for domestic use and priced strictly in Naira. Starting with all government vehicles, we will transition to gas powered cars.

While we support private enterprises will you take measures to ensure that Nigeria does not get dominated by a small group of oligopolists and monopolists?

Free enterprise is about market forces and keen competition. These will occur at different levels. If we liberalize access to funding, SMEs will flourish; they have a role to play the giant companies no longer play. We will enforce the legal framework protecting

foreign investors and their indigenous partners. This is the only way to tamper monopoly and capital flight.

In respect of gender equality in business and politics, Nigeria is behind many African countries. Will you be taking this as a priority?

As governor of Anambra State, my administration achieved close to a 60-40 gender balance in appointive and elective positions. The national target has hovered around 30-35%. We intend to progressively aim for between 35-40%, with aggressive gender mainstreaming action plan and rigid benchmarks.

The Central Bank has lost the confidence of many inside and outside of Nigeria. What do you propose to do about this?

As part of our monetary policy, we will seek to reestablish the independence of the CBN; and commit to a credible and transparent plan to normalize the exchange rate and bring inflation to single digits.

We will remove import and forex restrictions and insist on a single forex market. The current system penalizes exporters who bring in forex by forcing them to sell at a rate that they are unable to source for forex when they need to purchase forex. This multiple exchange rate regime encourages capital flight and deters investment, which has further worsened Nigeria's forex situation.

Do you see yourself deepening or reducing ties with China?

Our trade policies will always be predicated on what is in our best national interest. Trade partners who offer us comparative advantage will be considered. However, we will give primacy to our Africa Trade Treaty obligations. Beneficiaries of China's goodwill and investments in Africa are many. So too are the countries defaulting on their Chinese loans. The trend is deeply alarming. Salutary, as it may seem, we must approach such engagement with our national interest uppermost in our minds.

What policy will your administration have



towards Russia and Ukraine?

We maintain very cordial relations with Russia and Ukraine. Evidently, this war, in conventional terms, will need to be resolved at the negotiations table. We support the cessation of hostilities agreement under the auspices of the United Nations.

CAMPAIGN FINANCE: NO LONGER BUSINESS AS USUAL

olitical parties and candidates require money to publicize their electoral platforms and to pursue effective campaigns. Attempts to regulate campaign finance reflect the commonly held belief that uncontrolled political fund-raising and spending can undermine the integrity of the democratic process and erode the confidence of the electorate in political institutions.

A global phenomenon, the massive growth in campaign finance is not peculiar to Nigeria as campaign expenditures have grown in many countries since the turn of the 21st century.

Campaign finance raises fundamental ethical questions for democratic regimes. Most often, debates about campaign finance revolve around the protection of freedom of expression and the prevention of corruption: two democratic principles that can enter into conflict with one another.

On the one hand, jurists have often considered financial participation in a campaign (either through donation or spending) to be a form of political expression that must be constitutionally protected from censorship. On the other hand, it is generally agreed that regulations and limits can justifiably be placed on campaign finance in order to prevent corruption.

All countries face the problem of the role and influence of money in politics, but each answers this problem with different values and policies. In the United States, campaign finance regulations have focused on limiting partisan contributions (rather than limiting spending by campaigns). Canada placed limits on both contributions and spending. In Nigeria, in order to rein in campaign finance abuses and ensure a level playing field for all contestants, the new Electoral Act 2022 spelt out campaign finance ceilings and penalties finance their election is critical

for violations. The campaign finance thresholds are in two folds: One for the candidates and another for the political parties.

Section 88 of the new Act places limitation of election expenses on candidates. Sub (2) says the maximum election expenses to be incurred by a candidate at a presidential election shall not exceed N5bn (Used to be N1bn); (3) The a candidate in respect of governorship election shall not exceed N1bn. (Used to be N200m) and so on...



The Electoral Act 2022 limits the amount of money any single donor can contribute to the campaign to N50m. By regulating campaign fund-raising and spending, governments seek to avoid a situation whereby politicians use the power associated with their office to reward large contributors. Even in the absence of any actual quid pro quo, large contributions can, in theory, contradict the democratic principle of "one person, one vote," since contributors gain a privileged channel to express their interests and opinions. In addition to preventing outright corruption, campaign finance regulation thus seeks to limit the undue influence of money in politics.

What represents undue influence is, however, itself a contested issue. The objective of campaign finance regulation can also be approached from a more positive perspectivenamely, that it can be used to empower the greatest number of citizens to voice their concerns and aspirations in a campaign.



he 2023 presidential election is occasioning a shift in attitudes towards electioneering Nigeria.

Buoyed by the entry into the race of Peter Obi, the former Governor of Anambra State whose stewardship as helmsman of the state continues to draw plaudits for his prudent and pragmatic approach to governance, which lifted the state from one of the least developed and unsafe in terms of security, to a thriving entity by the time he left office in 2016. Ukraine war: US condemns 'brutal' **Russian strikes on Ukraine**

ussia has been widelv condemned after bombarding cities across including Ukraine, launching missile strikes on the centre of Kyiv for the first time. The US said the "brutal" attacks had hit non-military targets, including a university and children's playground, and promised further military aid. chief United Nations said Antonio Guterres "deeply shocked". was Vladimir Putin said the attacks were retaliation for Saturday's explosion on a key bridge linking Russia to Crimea. 
