**Operation Instructions**

1. Operate ONLY from operator seat. Keep hands and feet inside while operating.
2. ALWAYS fasten seat belt(s) before operating.
3. Use shoulder belt(s) when operating at high range speeds.
4. Do not exceed the load capacities including Loader Rated Operating Capacity (ROC), Maximum Cargo Box Load, Machine Rated Capacity and Total Rated Capacity.
5. Keep heavy end of machine uphill when operating on slopes and CARRY LOAD LOW.
6. NEVER go under or reach under lift arm or cargo box unless supported by an approved support device. Separate support devices for the lift arm and cargo box are provided.
7. NEVER carry riders in cargo box or on lift arms. One passenger can ride in machine.
8. To Leave the Machine:
  - Lower the lift arm and put attachment flat on the ground.
  - Put travel direction control lever in PARK and all controls in NEUTRAL.
  - STOP the engine.
  - Raise arm rest.
