


Use standard methods and practices when attaching snowplow and installing accessories, including proper personal protective safety equipment.

A CAUTION

See your FISHER® outlet/Web site for specific vehicle application recommendations before installation. Steel deflector weight information may be found in the eMatch selection system.

 Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Lower the blade to the ground, and turn the control OFF. Disconnect the snowplow from the vehicle or turn the vehicle ignition to the OFF position and remove the key.

- For HD2™ installations: Skip to Step 3.
 For HDX™ installations: Remove the existing fasteners along the top edge of the moldboard.
- Align the deflector on the top of the blade, matching up the holes in the deflector with the holes in the top bar or moldboard.
- 4. Fasten the deflector to the snowplow with the supplied 3/8" x 1-1/2" cap screws, washers and locknuts as shown. Torque fasteners to 18 ft-lb
