

PRODUCTION MANAGER NYT REP COMPANY

The National Youth Theatre (NYT) is a world-leading youth arts charity. The NYT REP Company is made up of sixteen NYT acting members aged 18-26 from across the country. For the first 8 weeks, they take part in unique vocational, industry-based training with high-profile industry artists. After this, they begin rehearsals for three productions at which point a team of NYT Backstage Members join the productions to further their training.

We are looking for an experienced Production Manager to support these productions and company as they move across different venues. The shows are separate and will have a different Creative Team.

JOB DESCRIPTION

- Managing all the production elements and technical requirements of each production.
- Liaising with the NYT production team, each Creative team to support all elements of the production as on any Professional Theatre Production
- Attending site visits to theatres
- Creating and managing the production schedule, sourcing and transporting all technical equipment, props, set and costumes, coordinate the rehearsal set and oversee the set build, install, Get-in and Get-Out and any other technical rehearsals as required.
- To attend and chair all weekly Production meetings relating to the production/s
- The Production Manager will ensure the rehearsal venue and performance venue meet all necessary production requirements and health and safety legislation.
- To liaise and maintain positive relationships with all NYT departments as well as the in-house teams at the chosen Performance venues.
- Liaise with heads of departments regarding the costing, purchase and delivery of all production materials
- To oversee the fit up and strike of the set, and to take a hands-on role throughout production week.
- The Production Manager will be responsible for managing and monitoring the production budget and all related expenditure and working with the Head of Producing to make sure the production is completed to budget and on schedule
- Providing support to the Company Manager and stage management team when necessary
- To organise transportation for the Production and be responsible for managing all returns and or hires as required.
- Where possible, to be responsible for mentoring NYT Technical Members working on the shows, ensuring their optimum learning experience.
- The Production Manager is required to have an up-to-date DBS certificate and undergo Safeguarding training, both of which can be provided by NYT.
