



About the venue




All performances take place in our **Workshop Theatre**


It can hold up to 140 audience members




We have a box office you can buy tickets from



It is open **10am - 6pm** on **Monday - Saturday**



It is open **10am - 5pm** on **Sundays**



We have a bar serving drinks and snacks

It opens **1 hour** before performance begins




Theatre doors will open **15 minutes** before performance starts

Accessing the theatre



When you arrive you will be asked if you already **have a ticket** or if you'd like **to buy one**

We are a cash free venue



Once you've spoken to our reception team you can use the **stairs or the platform lift**




Go through the **green doors** into the theatre bar



The theatre entrance has a neon sign above it

Once the **doors are open** you can go in



Show your ticket from your phone at the door of the theatre

About the facilities



When entering the green room outside the theatre, the toilets are **on the right**

There are a range of cubicle toilets including a **disabled toilet** and a **Changing Places Toilet**




NYT's Theatre is **wheelchair accessible**

There is a **platform lift** from reception to the upper ground floor of the building



There are **blue badge parking** bays nearby on Holloway Road


Relaxed performances

- a chill out space is available





What is provided





