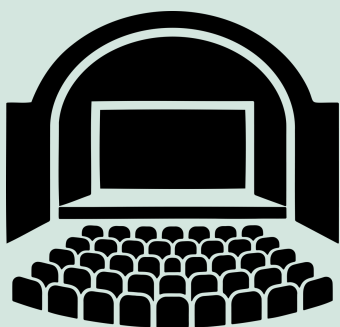
Visual Guide Easy Read

About the event



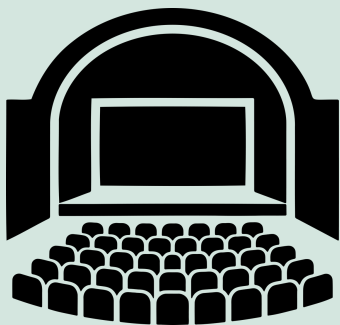
LOVE BITES! is a screening of a film and an after party

This will start at **8pm** and finish at **10pm**

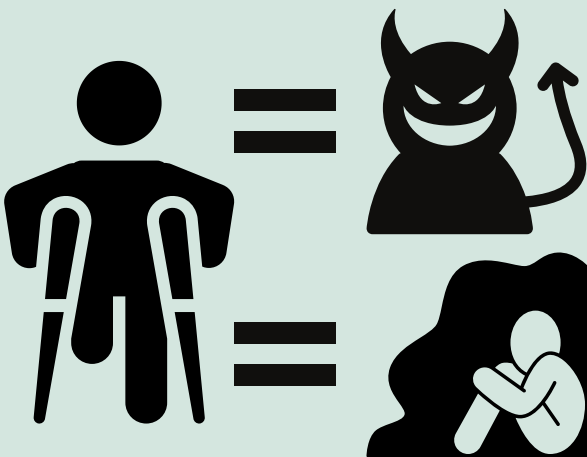
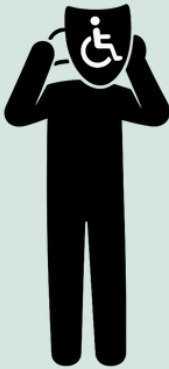
About the film

- disability as a metaphor for fear / evil

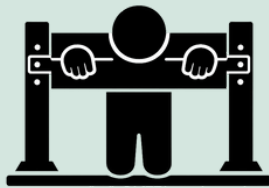


Misogyny
