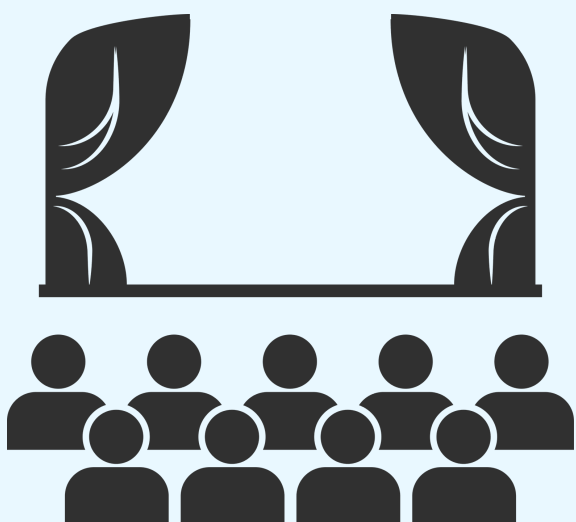
Visual Guide Easy Read

Let The Right One In is a live theatre performance

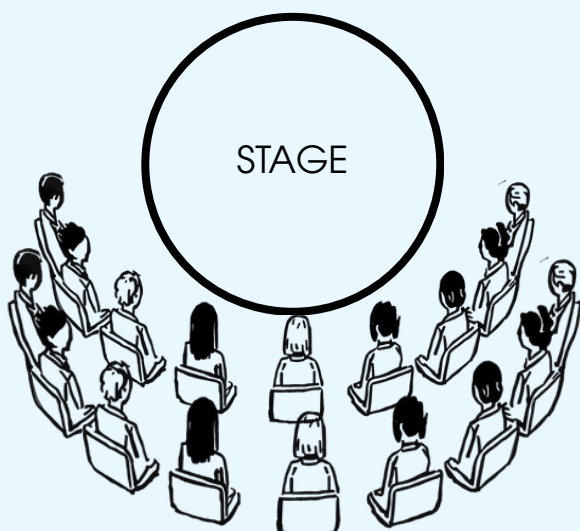


The performance will last **approximately 2 hours.**

The show will be performed **in traverse.**

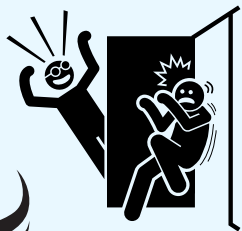
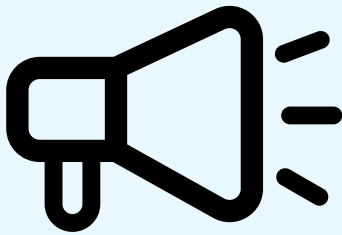
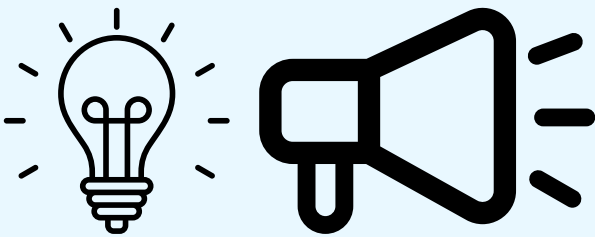
This means there will be audience on either side of the stage.

There will be a group of **20 actors** who perform in the show

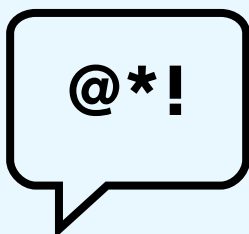
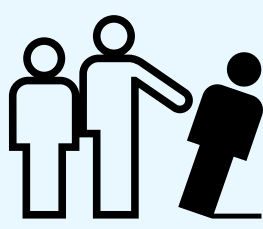
Some actors might play more than 1 character

- Haze

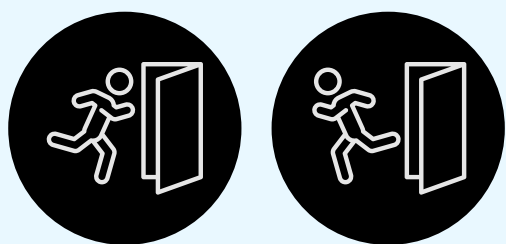
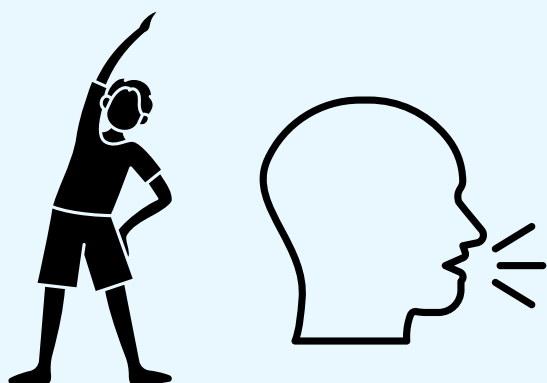

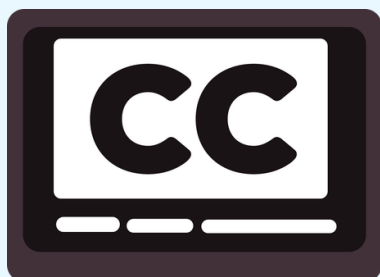
Access performances

- a chill out space is available before and during the show

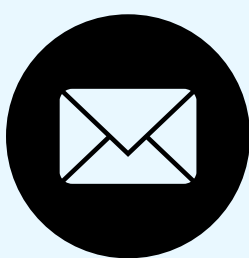


Captioned performance

The performance will have headseats available for audience members. The action on stage will be described

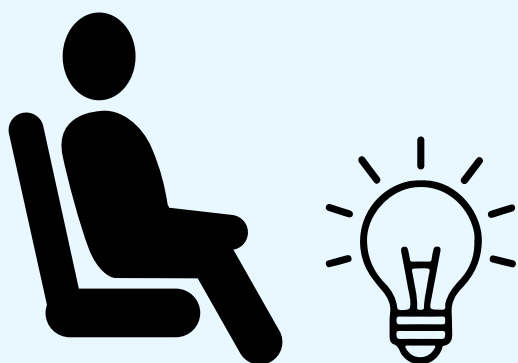

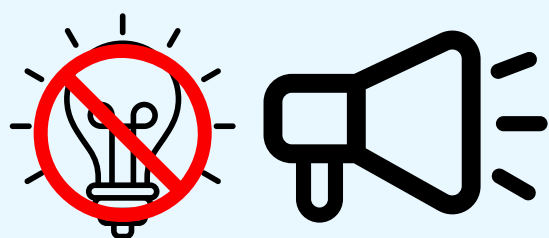
Access performances



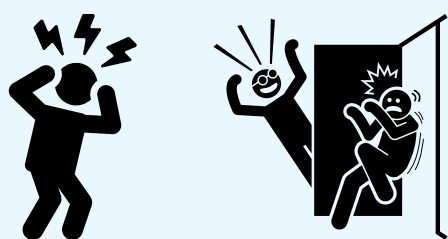
Visual Cue Seats
