

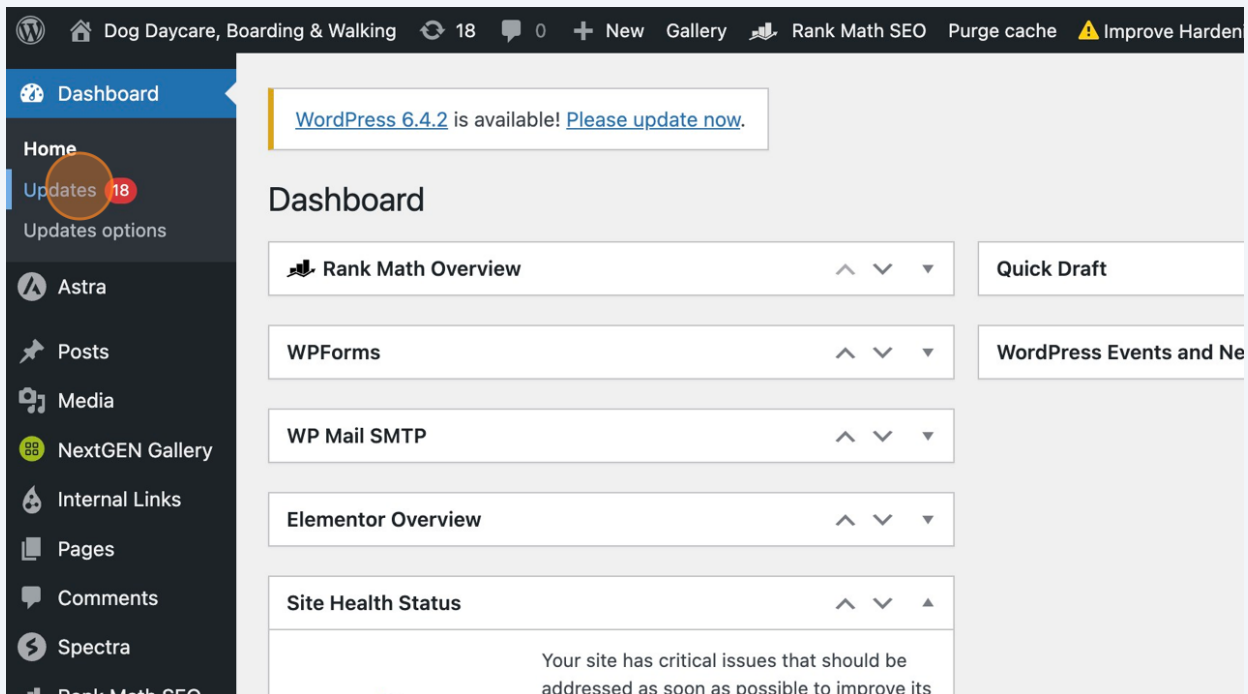
Beginners Guide: WordPress Maintenance - Scribe[®] Updating WordPress, Plugins and Themes

This beginner's guide provides step-by-step instructions on how to update WordPress, plugins, and themes. It emphasizes the importance of taking backups before updating and provides tips on how to approach updating plugins based on their version numbers. The guide also covers updating themes and translations, as well as updating the WordPress core. It reminds users to clear their cache and review their website after updates. Overall, this guide is a comprehensive resource for beginners who want to learn how to properly maintain their WordPress website.

1 Navigate to your Wordpress website login. Typically it looks something like <https://www.yourdomain.co.uk/wp-admin>

Log in with your credentials. You must have full access, so be sure to log in as an administrator.

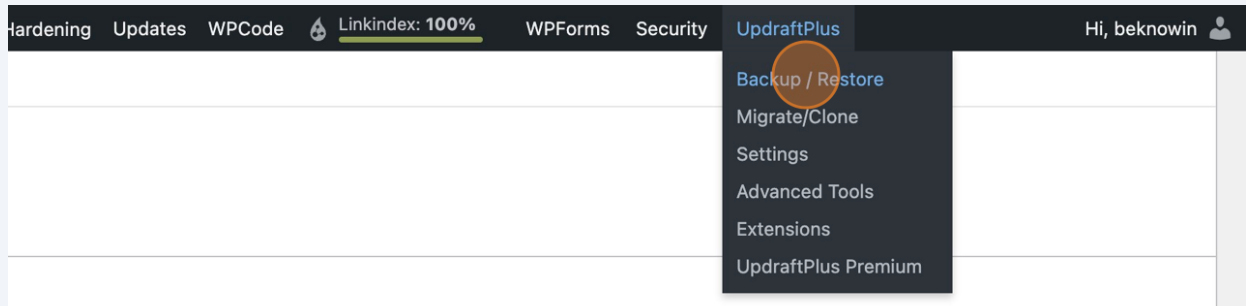
2 Notice the red dot with a number - this shows how many items need updating.



But first we ALWAYS ALWAYS ALWAYS take a back-up just in case something goes wrong.

3 Use whichever backup plugin you have installed, in this case, I am using Updraft.

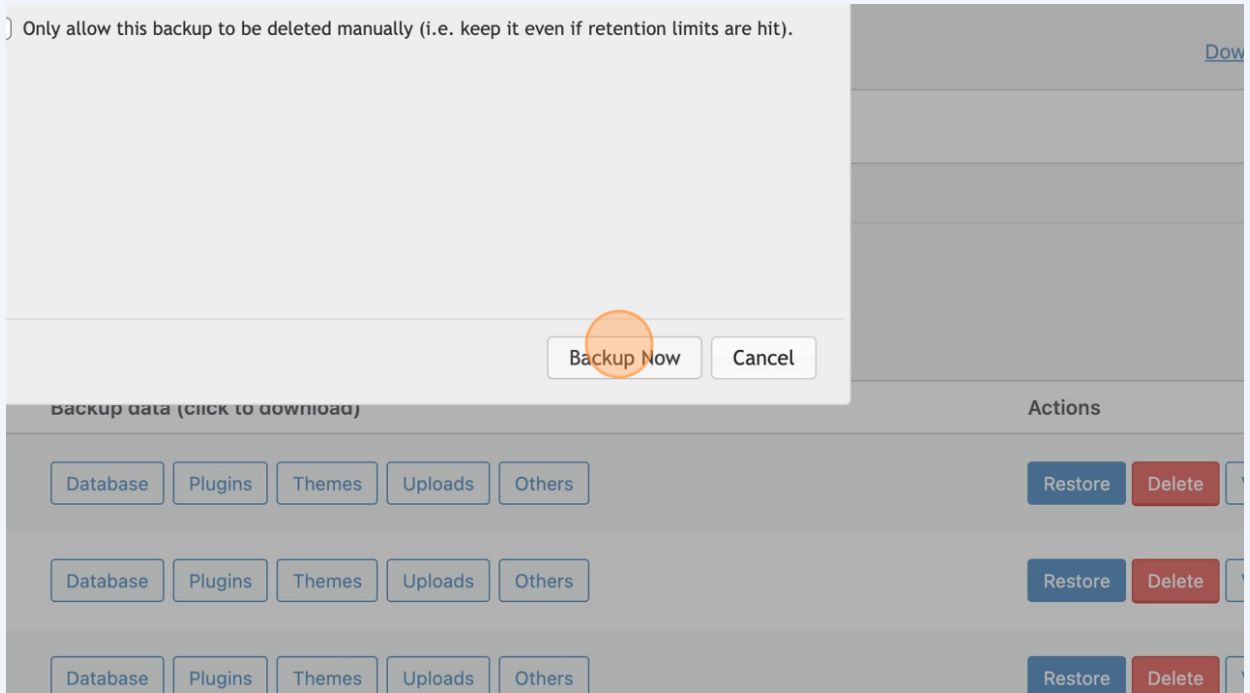

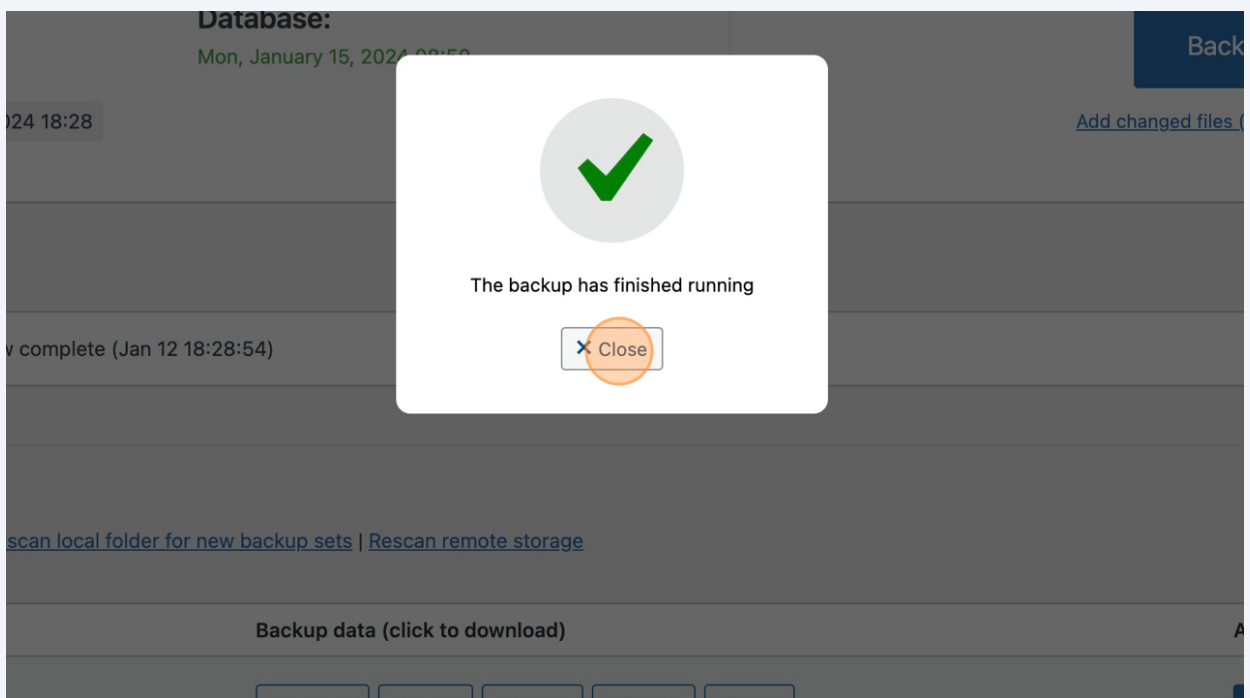

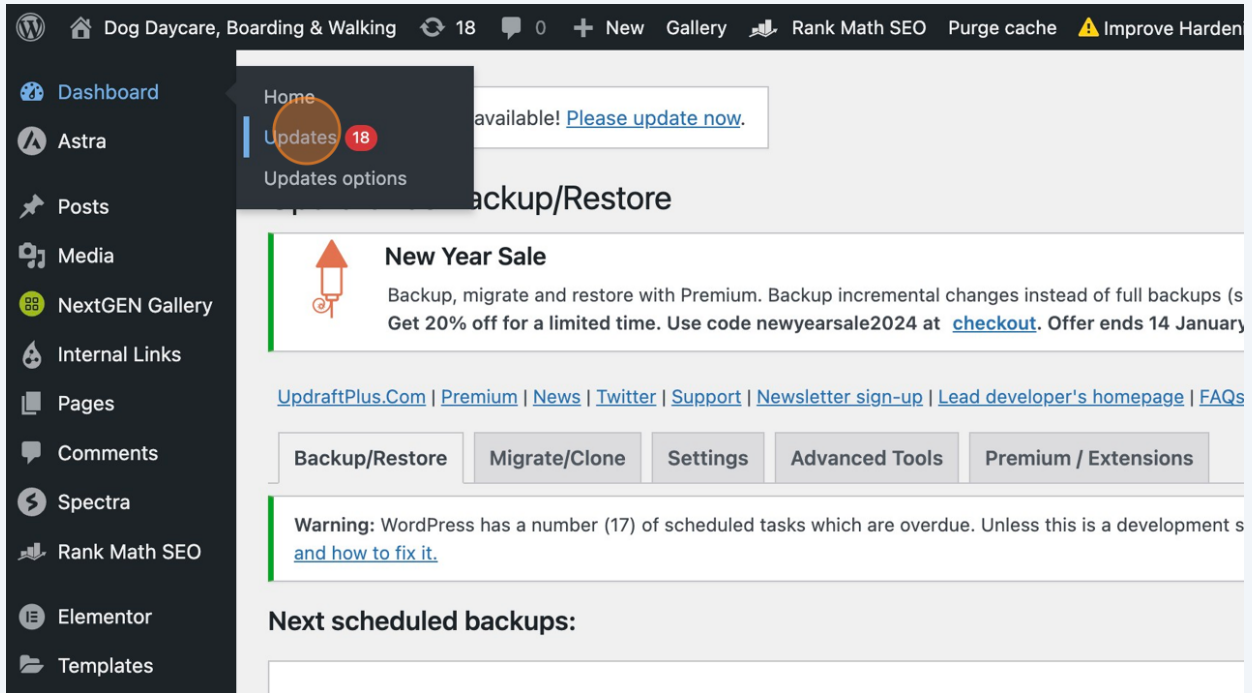


6 Once it's complete, you can click "Close"

Let's start updating - You can go to Dashboard and select "Updates"



8 If you want to, you can Click the "Select all" field.

This will do a blanket update of all plugins. Since we have so many plugins to update, I prefer to start with a more considered approach.

Have you ever wondered why version numbers have 2 to 3 digits 1.2.11 or 2.3, well generally these denote whether the update is minor or major.


2.3.11 to 2.3.12 suggests a small update has been made, possibly a tweak or quick bug fix (x.x.11 update to x.x.12)

2.3.12 to 2.4 however suggests a more important update but is still relatively minor (2.3.x to 2.4)

When we see updates to the first number, eg 3.4 to 4.0 this is a major update and more fundamental changes to code have been made, which in turn can have bigger impacts to your website (3.x.x to 4.x).

For that reason, I like to start with updating the plugins with minor updates, then the slightly more important updates and finish with the major ones. Each time clearing my cache and checking how the website appears on the front end to visitors.

You can also update each plugin one by one with a check following each update, just to make sure.
