## DOCUMENTS CONSTITUTING YOUR MEDICAL RECORD

### Recent Medical Summary (< 3 months) Prepared by Your Attending Physician

- Medical and Surgical History
- List of current treatments or medications
- Description of lifestyle (e.g., diet, activity level, smoking, etc.)
- Report on symptoms, discomfort, and how they affect daily life

### Recent Test Results (< 3 months)

- Medical Laboratory Results
- Medical Imaging (radiology, CT scan, MRI, ultrasound reports + images in DICOM format)

### Others documents :

- Medical Reports (consultations, hospital stays, surgeries, etc.)
- ELSAN "Request for Coverage" Form sent by email



## ATTENTION

To process your file correctly, all medical documents must clearly show your full name, date of birth, and the date when the exam was done.

This information helps us confirm your identity and avoid any medical mistakes. Also, documents need to be signed and stamped by a doctor.

Please note that photos of medical images (like X-rays, ultrasounds, CT scans, MRIs) or documents, as well as medical letters that are hard to read, cannot be used.

They don't meet our quality standards for proper care. We recommend scanning your documents instead of taking photos, because photos can sometimes be blurry or unclear.

### For documents in other languages:

We only accept official documents written in French or English. If your documents are in another language, you'll need to provide a certified translation.
