In addition to adding safety for patients, the equipment offers enhanced safety and efficiency for caregivers. The use of the new GlideScope minimizes close contact during an intubation and increases efficiency.

The equipment is used primarily in surgery and is also used to support patient care in the Intensive Care Unit and Emergency Department.
