**PLEASE NOTE:** All visitors must be at least 18 years old and wear a mask, symptom screen, and sanitize their hands. Visitors to patients who are COVID-19 positive must follow safety guidelines specific to those units. Anyone who is sick, has a fever, has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 20 days, or has been exposed to someone with COVID-19 within the last 14 days should not visit or accompany a patient. Visitation guidelines are subject to change if safe physical distancing isn't possible. Compassionate exceptions permitted when necessary.

A compassionate visit is any circumstance where a patient's care team determines that a visitor is critical for assistance with physical or emotional care.
