# PRESIDENT'S REPORT

*2017 Annual Report*



For the Blue Mountain Community Foundation, 2016-2017 was an outstanding year. The Board of Trustees is pleased to report that the Community Foundation continues to grow and prosper for the good of the Blue Mountain region and the Walla Walla Valley.

The assets of the Community Foundation have increased over 40% since the 2013 FY, thanks to a combination of investment results, robust contributions, bequests and the creation of new agency funds. Last year several remarkable gifts were received, including the initial permanent transfer from the Prosser Scholarship Fund, which when complete, will exceed \$5 million. The Olney, Prosser and Burnham-Caulkins scholarships were awarded for the first time in Spring 2017 through the Community Foundation. Local Prosser dollars were awarded to Prosser High School students by a volunteer committee of Prosser residents.

Another remarkable gift of \$1 million created the Warren Community Action Fund, which made its first grants in 2016-2017, totaling \$50,000. Through this fund, the Warren family is continuing to be a force for good in our area.

This is what the Blue Mountain Community Foundation is all about -- partnering with donors and charities to improve the quality of life in our communities. Our mission is to connect people, charitable causes and community needs.

The potential for the Community Foundation's services, growth and impact is immense!

# EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

2017 Annual Report

In 2016-17, the Blue Mountain Community foundation saw another year of growth through increased programs, grants, and partnerships. Our assets have increased over 40% in the past four years, primarily through gifts, grants and bequests as well effective stewardship of current assets.

2016 also saw an expansion in BMCF services for nonprofit organizations and charities to go beyond agency funds to scholarship providers and other grantmakers. The Prosser Scholarship Fund's decision to permanently transfer \$5 million to BMCF for administration of their assets and scholarship program opened a new line of services by the Community Foundation.

BMCF can partner with local private foundations and charitable trusts as well as nonprofit organizations to manage assets and perform administrative tasks while continuing a philanthropy's grantmaking. This partnership can take many forms that respond to the unique mission, needs and processes of each organization. As a result, a long-time charity can maintain its identity and mission while moving asset management and administration to BMCF.



Another exciting development is the fulfillment of a long-time dream of the Christian Aid Center in Walla Walla. Sometime in the foreseeable future, the Christian Aid Center will begin spending its agency funds at BMCF for a new building to support homeless women and families. This is another service available to nonprofit organizations – the creation of agency funds to hold and grow assets that will someday be used for a major project.

Our richly diverse communities are charitable and community-minded. Sometimes I think that people do not value what they have the most of, whatever that may be! In our rural communities, people are definitely valued and appreciated. We are building goodwill, understanding and cooperation among diverse peoples and organizations. There are several formal programs underway to reduce stigma, fear and distrust among people as well as embrace diversity, equity and inclusion. We need to get to know and better understand each other. Let's work together for the greater good.

## A LEGACY OF GIVING IN PROSSER

In 2016 the Community Foundation received the transfer of assets from the Prosser Scholarship Fund and opened three new scholarship funds to support the graduates of Prosser high schools.

The Prosser Scholarship Fund was established in 1975 by James Houston, a Prosser High graduate who benefited from community assistance to attend college. Local Prosser business people joined the cause, and to-date, the fund has given over \$100,000 in scholarships to Prosser graduates.

The Olney Scholarship Fund was established in 2006 by Leota Olney to honor her parents, Edward and Julia. Today the fund holds more than \$1.5 million and awards renewable scholarships of \$2,000 a year to Prosser graduates.

The Merle Burnham-Caulkins Scholarship Fund was established by the generous gift of Merle Burnham-Caulkins and Howard Caulkins. The two greatly valued education and chose to donate their estate to benefit future generations of graduates from Prosser high schools.

This year, 45 scholarships totaling \$90,000 were awarded to graduates of Prosser high schools.

# WARREN FAMILY AWARDS FIRST YEAR GRANTS

It has been nearly two years since the creation of the Warren Community Action Fund by the Warren Family to honor their parents Robert and Nadine Warren. Sadly, Robert Warren passed away in 2017. The fund was created to primarily support organizations in Columbia and Walla Walla counties. Reviewing applications and making grant recommendations was a team effort among their children. BMCF received 32 applications by the May 1st deadline for this first round of grants.

# COMMUNITY CONVERSATIONS

*2017 Annual Report*

Community Conversations sought to engage a diverse group of people in a process to develop a regional vision for the future that is inclusive and far-sighted. This nearly year-long process successfully engaged over 450 participants, generated over 800 ideas and resulted in a list of five top regional priorities: Access to Education, Strong and Diverse Economy, Health and Wellbeing, Care for Nature, and Safety. Two values – civic engagement and commitment to diversity – were identified as central in all work moving forward. In addition, 160 participants indicated an interest in working in action groups, and 39 said they are interested in taking a leadership role.



One of the most significant challenges to identifying regional priorities that are truly shared by the whole community is engaging a diverse population in the process. To do that, project leaders worked with key resource people and “trusted messengers” to conduct outreach and create workshop settings that were comfortable and accessible. Special effort was made to engage young families, whose busy schedules often preclude them from such activities, and Latino and Hispanic people, whose voices have often been left out of planning efforts. Large workshops offered qualified childcare, delicious food, and professional interpretation services as needed.



Community Conversations will affect the future of the region. Perhaps most importantly, the process set a new standard for community engagement. Many community leaders reported that they have never seen such diverse audiences in community planning processes. Another result is the emergence of new community leaders – individuals who have volunteered to help organize stakeholders and champion identified priorities. Further, information gathered through the process is being incorporated into city and county comprehensive planning efforts. Priorities are being used by local funding agencies to align philanthropic giving. Most recently, Community Council received the Duane Wollmuth Catalyst Award from the Walla Walla Chamber of Commerce for its work in helping to convene this important community effort.

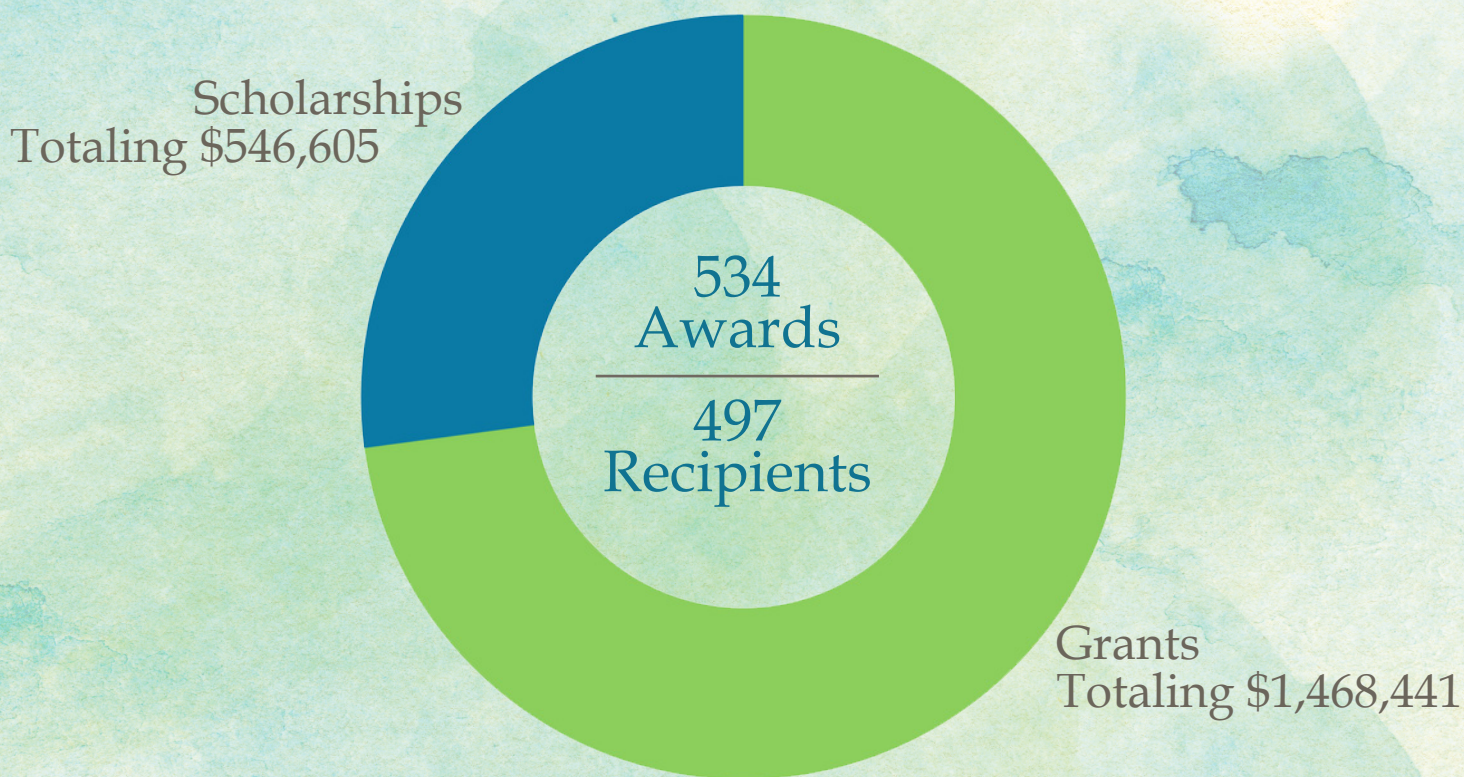
