PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2018 Annual Report

Welcome to the 2017-2018 Annual Report of the Blue Mountain Community Foundation! With the support of a terrific staff team and active involvement of our outstanding Board of Trustees, I am pleased to report that this year our Community Foundation has continued to grow and serve our communities.

The significant increase in assets continued as in the previous year through generous gifts and investment performance. The greatest increase, however, was in the amount of charitable distributions from BMCF to our communities. A quantum jump was made over last year in the amount of grants and scholarships paid, from \$2 million to over \$3.5 million.

Of this amount, nearly \$1 million was spent by nonprofit and charitable organizations out of the funds they had asked BMCF to manage and invest on their behalf.



Of the \$2.5 million remaining, over \$500,000 in scholarships were awarded to 272 worthy recipients. The remaining \$2 million was directly distributed from BMCF designated and donor advised funds to nonprofits. Although gifts are made all over the U.S. at the recommendation of donors, most of these funds were received by local charities.

In 2017-2018 Trustee Tim Kennedy, founder of Tim's Cascade Chips and Don Carlo Winery, from Athena, OR, resigned, although he will continue to serve on several committees. In 2017-2018 we also welcomed board members Mark Kajita, CEO of Baker Boyer Bank, and Steve Van Ausdler, President Emeritus of Walla Walla Community College.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

2018 Annual Report



The Blue Mountain Community Foundation is celebrating a banner fiscal year in 2018! We have now achieved \$50 million in assets, and distributed over \$3.5 million to our region – our largest funding milestone to date. We celebrate the generosity of the people of the Blue Mountain region, as well as the tremendous commitment of time and savvy advice from volunteers that are instrumental to BMCF's investment, grants, scholarships and development programs. Celebrating financial growth and achievements is hollow, however, without also celebrating the work in the community.

Examples of better living in the Blue Mountain region last year due in part to Blue Mountain Community Foundation support:

- Our communities are becoming more resilient due to extensive trauma-informed programs in the region, thanks to the work of the Community Resilience Initiative (Blue Mountain Action Council as fiscal sponsor);
- A BMCF grant helped a collaboration of five organizations' fulfill their dream of a state-of-the-art Student Health Center,

homeless shelter for young people, an Early Head Start center and a place for other programs serving at risk youth, called The Hub.

- Awarded a grant to Walla Walla Community College Foundation to help Hispanic and Latino families navigate the higher education system. The grant was one awarded as part of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation's Building Community Philanthropy initiative in partnership with Philanthropy Northwest.

And we are ambitious for the Blue Mountain region - we want to do more.

Why grow the Community Foundation? To ensure that our communities have flexible charitable dollars available in perpetuity to solve problems and seize opportunities so that people have better lives.

Philanthropy – the business of raising, holding and investing funds on the one hand, and making grants and scholarships on the other– relies on the generosity and vision of people. It is deeply personal – those who wish to see a better world see philanthropy as one of the ways to change things for the better.

BMCF is working hard to be the philanthropic partner of choice for these visionaries. We focus on helping donors achieve their philanthropic goals, whether it is establishing a fund to endow their favorite nonprofit or charity in their hometown, establish a donor advised fund for streamlined giving or create a scholarship to invest in young people. We serve nonprofit organizations and charities through grants as well as access to institutional investment services for their endowments. And we serve individuals and the community at large who benefit from many programs and organizations supported by BMCF.

I look forward to working with you and your family to learn about your vision for your community, and how BMCF can assist you.

NEW SOCIALLY RESPONSIVE INVESTMENT FUND OPTION AT BMCF

The 2017-2018 Fiscal Year saw another milestone in BMCF history, the creation of a Socially Responsive Investment option. This fund focuses on investments that exclude tobacco, alcohol, gambling and adult entertainment companies, while including companies that are strong in the areas of social and environmental responsibility, diversity and governance. To date, the new investment option has attracted over \$1.1 million in new funds to the Community Foundation.



FUNDERS' TOUR OF WALLA WALLA VALLEY

In November 2017, Walla Walla was host to the first Walla Walla Valley Funders' Tour, co-sponsored by BMCF and the Sherwood Trust. The tour brought representatives from six foundations from around the region to the Walla Walla Valley to learn about the myriad programs and area nonprofit organizations. From Milton-Freewater, OR to Dayton, WA, the group spent two days touring, learning and meeting groups improving their communities.

Highlights of the 2017 tour included:

- An interactive Data Walk showcasing how communities have used data on local trends to engage the community and develop a vision for the entire Blue Mountain region, led by Community Council;
- A tour of "The Hub," Walla Walla teen center, to learn about the multi-agency collaboration and trauma-informed approach to serving youth and families while building resilience in the community;
- A tour of Dayton, Washington to learn how a small group of volunteers led the revitalization of the downtown corridor;
- A women's leadership and networking dinner, bringing together women from businesses, government, and nonprofit organizations, and;
- Individualized sessions with local nonprofit organizations according to each funders' area of interest.

As a result of the tour, many nonprofit organizations in the region were able to forge relationships with new grantmakers. The goal of the sponsors of the Funders' Tour is to offer a tour of the Walla Walla Valley each year.

LAMAR FARM - A GIFT IN PERPETUITY

The Walla Walla Valley is home to many farms that can trace their roots back to the late 1800s. The Valley is rich in many ways, including the productivity of the land, whether wheat, vegetables, fruit or wine grapes. The Lamar Farm produces an extra gift, scholarships!

The Community Foundation's Lamar Farm dates back to 1863. Through his will, James N. Lamar made sure that the farm remained in production, that the family name was kept alive, and that revenue from the farm supported scholarships for college students.

Inspired by the success of this arrangement, the Community Foundation has begun a program encouraging gifts of agricultural land. Producers now have the option of donating their land to the Community Foundation and dedicating its revenue to the good of the community in perpetuity. The family's name will continue to be associated with the land, and the

land remains in production. Revenue generated by the farm can be used to support the desired charitable cause of the donor. Tenant farmers may also be retained. The initiative's oversight is by the BMCF Farm Committee.

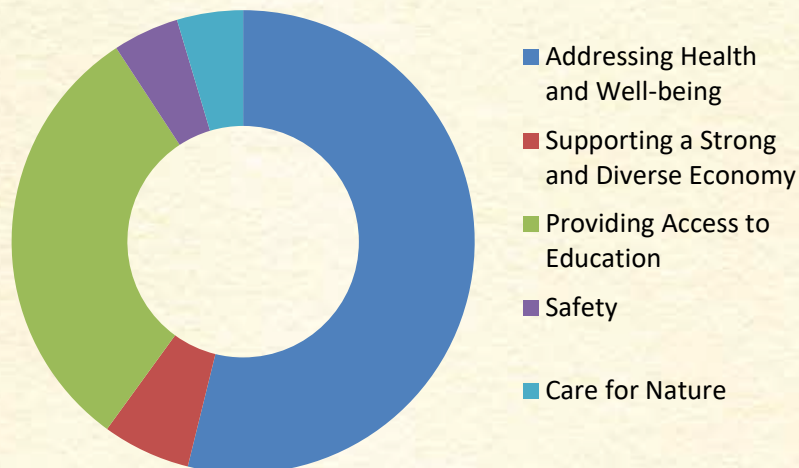
