



Essay Questions for BMCF Scholarship Application

The essay questions are the most important part of the scholarship application because your answers are the only way the evaluation committee can get to know who you are. If you only write a couple of sentences, you are not likely to get a scholarship, so please make sure to write thorough and complete essays, and check your grammar and spelling before submission.

There are four essay questions that are up to 3,000 characters each, including spaces. This translates into approximately 600 words per essay. Do not go over the allotted words as the system will not accept your essay when you copy and paste it into the application.

As well, you do not want to write less than about 400 words because less than that will not give the scholarship committee enough information to evaluate.

1. What have you experienced, or who do you know that has had the most impact on your life, and what is that impact?
2. What are your career goals, and why did you choose that particular career path?
3. What would your superpower be, and how would you use it to help others?
4. If you had the time and money after you graduate, what would you do to make your community better?
