Bozeman Health Care Sites Implement Employee, Patient, and Vendor Entrance Screenings

Here's what's happening...

Starting tomorrow, March 21, 2020 at 7 a.m., all employees, providers, patients, and vendors will be screened at all Bozeman Health care site entrances for a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher.

We want to ensure that everyone that enters a Bozeman Health care site is protected from any respiratory concerns and feel this is necessary to keep our staff and patients safe.

If you are an employee of Bozeman Health and are turned away from an entrance due to fever, please contact your supervisor immediately to let them know you will not be able to make your scheduled shift. Incident Command requests that over this weekend, any employee or provider are evaluated at b2 UrgentCare Main Street to receive return to work guidelines. Big Sky Medical Center employees may be evaluated in the BSMC emergency department bay.

Next week, employees needing evaluation will be referred to the Viral Triage Clinic on the Deaconess Hospital campus that will be located at entrance 4. Big Sky Medical Center employees may be evaluated in the BSMC emergency department bay.
