## COVID-19 RESPONSE POLICY/PROTOCOL

Trained ol (TO)	bserver	Prior to assisting doffing, please perform Hand Hygiene and don gloves. Assist health care worker (HCW) with doffing sequence and observe for any contamination  If you observe the HCW contaminate their hands please ask them to pause and perform hand hygiene before continuing with the doffing sequence					
HCW	Gown (remove in patient room at the door)	Stand in doorway or designated doffing station, turn away from others, pull gown off inside out and roll into a ball keeping contaminated side inside. Keep gloves on if possible. If gloves come off, remove them from gown.  Step outside room and drop reusable gown into Purple/Pink laundry bin using foot to open lid
