PURPOSE: To provide an alternative location for emergent lactation services, during closed hours of the Bozeman Health Pediatrics, that is safe for staff members, mothers and newborns.

POLICY/PROTOCOL:

1. The Mother/baby will arrive for their appointment at Entrance 7, complete the screening process, and be escorted by the lactation specialist to the Cancer Center Conference Room for their after-hours lactation appointment. The appointment must be completed during the open hours of Entrance 7 (0600-1900).
2. Following the appointment, the mother/baby will be escorted back to entrance 7 to ensure they have exited safely and are not left unattended in the building.
3. Additional people will not be allowed in the building for the appointment, this includes spouse/partner, other children, friends, grandparents, etc.
4. Response to Safety Issues:
 - Security at entrance 7 will be notified by the lactation specialist of the lactation appointment occurring in the Cancer Center Conference Room, prior to the mother/baby arriving. Security will assist with unlocking and locking the Cancer Center Conference Room door.
 - In the event of a security issue, staff will call a Code Gray by dialing "5555."
 - In the event of a Code Blue or Code Blue PALS the staff member calls for help, starts CPR, and the help that arrives will call 911 and bring the AED.
