- Wound Care APC will provide essential service to residents from recall list prioritization
- Wound Care will coordinate scheduling with staff at HSL
- Bozeman Health approved PPE guidelines will be implemented and followed during scheduled appointment

NOTES:

Hillcrest Senior Living residents are considered high risk patients who are at risk of developing develop diabetic foot ulcers without proper healthcare management.
