

## COVID-19 Test Sites, Viral Triage Clinics, and Hotline Information

Hotline hours are Monday to Friday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

### COVID-19 Test Sites

- Bozeman Health Belgrade Clinic + Urgent Care—Drive-up
- Bozeman Health Deaconess Hospital, Parking Lot G—Drive-up
- Big Sky Medical Center—Drive-up
- b2 UrgentCare Main Street—Walk-up

At this time, COVID-19 Test Sites in Bozeman and Belgrade will be performing nasal swab testing for COVID-19 and other respiratory infections for individuals **with an existing order** from a provider. If an individual doesn't have an order, they can see a provider at a b2 Care site, contact their healthcare provider, visit a Viral Triage Clinic (see below), or contact the COVID-19 Hotline before showing up at a test site to see if a test is appropriate. At drive-up COVID-19 Test Sites, patients will remain in their vehicles while screened.

At Big Sky Medical Center, after the provider orders a test, the individual will be given a contact number to call. The staff at BSMC will guide the individual over the phone to drive to the ambulance bay and once at the ambulance bay staff will direct the individual through the process. Patients will remain in their vehicles while screened.

**b2 UrgentCare Main Street, b2 MicroCare, and b2VirtualCare** remain available for patients who need a medical evaluation.

The VTC is the location where individuals with respiratory and/or viral symptoms will be evaluated and treated. Individuals will be routed through the VTC if:

- They present to Deaconess Hospital with fever and/or or respiratory symptoms.
- They are told by their primary care provider to visit the VTC.
- They present at the VTC.
