Updated Visitor Passport Guidelines

Here's what's happening...

We understand how important visitors/caregivers are to our patients when they are at one of our Bozeman Health care sites receiving care. A patient's attending provider may authorize appropriate visitors/caregivers for unique situations.

When a caregiver or visitor is approved to be with a patient, they will be given a visitor passport. This visitor passport helps all caregivers and the door screeners ensure visitors have been properly designated to visit or accompany their loved ones. A visitor passport will be given out in these specific scenarios:

- Imminent end of life
- Pediatric care
- Obstetric care
- Special needs care
- Other special reasons as indicated by area granting passport

A caregiver is defined as one healthy adult only. A visitor or caregiver that is granted a passport is allowed to enter a Bozeman Health facility. They must be wearing a mask or face covering when they enter a Bozeman Health care site.

Please note that each passport is re-evaluated if the patient transfers to a new department. Every visitor passport is authorized and signed by the attending provider. An authorized start and end date will be designated on each passport. If you currently utilize a passport in your unit or department, **please dispose of the old version** and order new passport cards through the Print Shop.

For example:

To: Bozeman Health Staff Please be advised that John Smith has been designated an approved essential visitors as follows:

Imminent end of life care
Obstetric care

Newborn care Special needs care

Other:

They are allowed to enter the Bozeman Health facility wearing a mask or face covering as long as they pass the currently established protocol for visitor screening. Visitor passport necessity will be re-evaluated if the patient transfers to a new department.
