

## Equipment and Room Cleaning and Management Guidelines

The purpose of this guideline is to outline what is recommended for cleaning Reusable PPE, Care Equipment, or Spaces

<b>Item</b>	<b>Cleaning Method</b>	<b>Can this item be shared <u>after</u> cleaning or laundering?</b>	<b>Can clean/ laundered item be used for single use or Extended Use?</b>	<b>Where do I put this PPE for cleaning/laundrying or once I have cleaned it?</b>
<b>Washable Gown</b>	In house launder	Yes	Single	Purple/pink linen bin
<b>Reusable Eye Protection</b>	Clean with hospital grade disinfectant	Yes	Single	Return clean eye protection to donning station
<b>Disposable Eye Protection</b>	Clean with hospital grade disinfectant	No	Single	Assign to single user, store for reuse
<b>Reusable Mask</b>	In house launder (Remove filter first)	Yes	Extended Use (unless soiled, wet or damaged)	Purple/pink linen bin
<b>N95 Mask</b>	Sterilization	No	Extended use (unless soiled, wet or damaged)	Dirty PAPR/N95 Bin
<b>P95/P100</b>	Sanitization	Yes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clean after each use</li> <li>• Extend use for single user during shift</li> </ul>	Dirty PAPR/N95 Bin
<b>PAPR hood 3M</b>	Clean after doffing with hospital grade disinfectant, sterilize prior to another user	Yes, after sterilization	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clean after each use</li> <li>• Extend use for single user during shift</li> </ul>	Dirty PAPR/N95 Bin
<b>PAPR hood Simms/Camo</b>	Clean after doffing with hospital grade disinfectant <b>wipe</b>	No	Clean after each use	Assign to single user, store for reuse
<b>PAPR device</b>	Clean with hospital grade disinfectant	Yes, after disinfection	Clean after each use	Return clean PAPR to donning station

Item/Environment	Disinfectant	Protocol	Additional Information	PPE
Reusable patient equipment	Hospital grade disinfectant, clean prior to use on another patient	Clean per normal protocols	Use dedicated equipment if possible for patient or a cohort of patients	Gloves
Inpatient rooms	Hospital grade disinfectant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clean per normal protocols</li> <li>Terminally clean per EVS protocol plus UV light</li> </ul>	Clean high touch surfaces 2x daily	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Gown &amp; gloves</li> <li>Eye protection and mask <b>if</b> splashes or sprays anticipated</li> </ul>
Procedural or ambulatory rooms and surfaces	Hospital grade disinfectant	Clean per normal protocols	Use UV light if available	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use PAPR or N95 for specified timeframe <b>if</b> after aerosol generating procedure</li> </ul>
Linen, dietary and waste	Management of laundry, food service utensils, and medical waste should also be performed in accordance with routine procedures.
