**PURPOSE:**

With the phased reopening of Bozeman Health to non-essential/non-emergent services during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Family Birth Center at Bozeman Health Deaconess Hospital will adopt routine testing of all patients presenting to labor and delivery in anticipation of the potential for a need to proceed with emergent delivery by cesarean section. This will allow reduction of use of respirators for those patients for whom test results are negative prior to delivery and reduction of need for isolation precautions postpartum (even if test results are not back until after the delivery).

**POLICY/PROTOCOL:**

Pregnant patients with scheduled delivery by cesarean section:

- Patients will complete COVID-19 PCR test 24-48 hours prior to scheduled admission
- Delivering provider or their associate will order pre-op testing. Order to be "orders only encounter" as a single order entry
  - Place order NBLD0624
  - Order Mode: No Cosign Required
  - Diagnosis Code: ID CODE: 1413353 (Z11.59 - encounter for screening for other viral diseases)
- Testing will be collected by trained laboratory personnel in the lot G drive-up testing site
- Patients will present for testing between 9AM and 12PM on the day specified by their provider
- Testing will be completed at the Bozeman Health in-house lab

Pregnant patients with scheduled labor induction:

- Patients will complete COVID-19 PCR test 24-48 hours prior to scheduled admission Delivering provider or their associate will order "pre-admission" testing. Order to be "orders only encounter" as a single order entry:
  - Place order NBLD0624
  - Order Mode: No Cosign Required
  - Diagnosis Code: ID CODE: 1413353 (Z11.59 - encounter for screening for other viral diseases)
- Testing will be collected by trained laboratory personnel in the lot G drive-up testing site
- Patients will present for testing between 9AM and 12PM on the day specified by their provider
- Testing will be completed at the Bozeman Health in-house lab



Pregnant patients presenting to the Family Birth Center for admission who have not been tested as above:

- Labor nurse will collect a sample for COVID19 PCR testing at the time of admission
- Testing will be ordered under the admitting provider:
  - Place order NBLD0624
  - Order Mode: No Cosign Required
  - Diagnosis Code if asked: ID CODE: 1413353 (Z11.59 - encounter for screening for other viral diseases)
- The anticipated procedure in this case would be surgical or natural childbirth.
- Testing will be completed at the Bozeman Health in-house lab

Results will be negative, positive, or unknown at the time of delivery for pregnant patients tested at admission and would follow the relevant pathway for care detailed in the maternity care document(s) listed below.

**NOTES:**

The requirement for pre-admission testing for COVID-19 for all patients presenting to the FBC may be contingent upon testing availability. Testing will preferentially be completed at BH lab.
