Child Care Options, Scholarships, Online Tutoring, and Other Options for Employees

Here's what's happening...

As the school year begins, we want to let employees know of some additional child care and tutoring options available to them as parents of school-age kids, as well as remind employees that Bozeman Health's trusted partners around the community remain committed to providing access to childcare for essential workers who may experience childcare facility and school closures. The facilities that have been identified still have capacity for parents in need of childcare around the Bozeman community.

Here's what you need to do...

Below is a list of childcare options that are committed to having openings available for the children of essential workers. If you have a need for childcare coverage please contact the providers below. Additionally, if you know an essential worker in the community who may be in need of a childcare solution, you are invited to share the information below.

Scholarships:

Child-care Connections: This is a scholarship that offers a flat award of \$4,000 per eligible family. This award is to be used for in-home care expenses or in another provider's home, such as that of a family members, friend, or neighbor who is providing unregulated care for the child(ren).

TO APPLY: Follow steps 1 - 4 to apply for this scholarship:

Determine which <u>Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) agency</u> you need to apply through

- 1. Apply through the <u>CCR&R</u> that serves your county
- 2 . Click <u>HERE</u> to find out which CCR&R to apply through
- 3. Child Care Connections serves Gallatin, Park, Meagher, Lewis & Clark, Jefferson, and Broadwater in Counties in Montana.
