Marie Sluberski and Barbara Dix have been busy getting the Fuzzy Friends distribution to many local businesses ramped up for the upcoming busy summer months! Many thanks to both ladies who continue to champion the Fuzzy Friends project and who also serve as our Membership/Sunshine committee and continue to make phone calls to check in with members to ensure all is well and everyone continues to weather the COVID storm.

Thank you to all who have sent in your 2022 membership dues! For those who have not yet had the opportunity to do so, we've included a reminder invoice with this mailing.

I am excited to announce the kickoff for our 2022 Raffle! This year's raffle goes back to our original format of an all-cash raffle but at only \$25 per ticket (5 tickets/\$100) and without the 400 ticket limit. Due to NJ state law, the Auxiliary is unable to display specific prize amounts on the tickets. We expect 1<sup>st</sup> price to have a value of **\$15,000** or greater based on the percentage of 37.5% of gross proceeds. The remaining five prizes are estimated to have a value of **\$1,000 or more** based on their percentage of 2.5% of gross proceeds. These combined percentages equal 50% of the overall raffle proceeds.

Last year's raffle was a tremendous success, raising \$18,000, and we are hoping to exceed last year's sales with our great cash prizes! Enclosed in this mailing an initial 10 tickets for you to purchase or sell. Tickets are \$25 each or 5 for \$100. Please do not hesitate to ask for more tickets to sell to your family and friends!
