The second cycle of grant support in 2019 was awarded in August. Eight local non-profits were awarded a total of <sup>\$</sup>96,110.00 to assist with their healthcare initiatives.

The Foundation was proud to support and partner with the following non-profit organizations: **Backpack Blessings, The Bike Box Project, Catholic Charities, Eastern Pregnancy Information Clinic, Hope Clinic, Mile of Hope Foundation, SECU Family House at UNC Hospitals, Uptown Business and Professional Association.** Combined with the first grant cycle, the Foundation supported 20 organizations totaling <sup>\$</sup>174,710 in fiscal year 2019.

The 10th annual Craven Cancer Classic was held on October 18, 2019 at the New Bern Golf & Country Club. Proceeds from this tournament support the Foundation's Scott Davenport/



Brian Fisher/John Aylward Cancer Warrior Fund. This fund has helped over 1,050 local cancer patients and family members with cancer-care related costs such as transportation, medical equipment, nutritional supplements, and lodging for out of town treatment.
