*It is not appropriate to approach a service animal to pet it or give it food or a treat. It is important to recognize that an animal is on duty and to confer directly with the person with the disability at all times.

Service Animals are defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act(ADA) as dogs or miniature horses that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. Service

Animals are permitted in CarolinaEast facilities.

Dogs whose sole function is to provide comfort or emotional support **do not** qualify as Service Animals under the ADA. CarolinaEast is not required to, nor do we permit, Emotional Support Animals in CarolinaEast facilities.

Dogs in CarolinaEast's canine visitation program "Thera-Paws: Furapy at its Best[©]" may be seen throughout the health system at any given time and can be identified by a blue vest and official CarolinaEast name badge. Therapy dogs that are part of this program are the only therapy dogs permitted in CarolinaEast facilities.
