The CarolinaEast Foundation is now requiring nonprofit organizations to submit a Letter of Intent (LOI) before sending a request for a full grant proposal. This is a change in our policy intended to help the nonprofits; not add work but to make sure the program goal of the nonprofit aligns with our mission closely. Before sending the LOI, we encourage you to review the CarolinaEast Foundation's mission and allocation policy to determine if your request is closely aligned with our funding guidelines.

Letters of intent should be one page, describing your organization and proposed project. Please submit the LOI on your organization's letterhead. The LOI should include the following:

Introduction

Please include a short executive summary that includes your organization's name, your mission, the amount of money requested, and a description of the project. Please explain how the project fits with our guidelines and mission and why it would be a good fit for the Foundation.

Organizational Description

Give a brief history of your nonprofit and provide an overview of your programs.

Statement of Need

Explain the need that can be met by your project. Describe the target population and geographical area. Include the outcomes of the project.

Please do not include additional information such as binders, books, videos, brochures, etc.

Inquiries should be submitted by October 16, 2020 to the CarolinaEast Foundation for the first grant cycle of FY 2021. The deadline for the Letter of Intent for the second grant cycle FY 2021 is May 14, 2021.
