The sixth annual Grin & Bear It 5K Run/ Walk will be held on Saturday, September


26, at Cass Regional Medical Center. This year's event will include additional family-oriented activities, including a Family Fun Run.

Charitable Gift Annuities

A charitable gift annuity, or CGA, is beneficial to both the donor and the organization. In exchange for a minimum gift of \$5,000 (and a minimum donor age of 60), the donor receives regular payments for life. After the donor's lifetime, a portion of the original gift will be made available to support a Cass Regional program or area of the donor's choosing.

For example, if an 80-year-old donor gives a gift of \$10,000, the annuity payment rate would be 6.8%. The annual payment amount would be \$680, which can be paid out annually, semi-annually, or quarterly. The estimated tax deduction for the gift would be \$4,731.

Annuity payments are made throughout the donor's lifetime and never decrease in value. In most cases, part of each annuity payment is income tax-free and the donor may qualify for a federal income tax deduction.
