Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia are devastating diseases that rob families of their loved ones. According to the Alzheimer's Association, more than 5 million Americans are currently living with Alzheimer's, with the estimated number rising to 16 million by 2050. Many such patients are treated within the Sage Senior Behavioral Health Unit

(BHU) at Cass Regional. The 10-bed unit provides each patient with a personal treatment team that addresses both their psychiatric and physical illnesses.

Now, thanks to generous donors just like you, the BHU will provide an extra level of care with the Music & Memory program. Research has proven that music therapy can make a significant positive impact on a patient's demeanor and quality of life. Given that the human brain is hard-wired to connect music with long-term memory, our caregivers utilize a patient's personalized selection of music to tap into deep memories that are not yet lost to dementia.




