Spring Scholarships Awarded

Congratulations to the following recent scholarship recipients:



Laura Hill, of Raymore, Missouri, was selected to receive the Alma Brown Scholarship. Hill has worked as a registered nurse on Cass Regional Medical Center's Med/Surg Unit since 2009, and is presently enrolled in the RN-BSN program at Grand Canyon University. She received a \$1,000 scholarship, which was made possible by the generosity of Alma Brown, who passed away in 1998.

Susan Miller, of Harrisonville, Missouri, was awarded the Wanda Brown Scholarship. Miller works as a licensed practical nurse on the Med/Surg Unit at Cass Regional Medical Center, and is pursuing an associate's degree in nursing in order to become a registered nurse. She received a \$1,000 scholarship, which was donated by the late Wanda Brown, who lived in Harrisonville for over 50 years and was very involved in civic affairs.
