
Proceeds from the commemorative bricks will be

used for the construction and ongoing maintenance of The Floyd and Franceline Parris Community Trail on the Cass Regional Medical Center campus. The trail is named in honor of Floyd and Franceline Parris, who operated a large farm in the Pleasant Hill area for many years before moving to Harrisonville in the early 1990s. Through her trust, Franceline left a significant donation to Cass Regional Medical Center Foundation, a portion of which has been designated by the foundation board as the lead gift for the trail project.

The trail is made possible entirely through donations, including proceeds from commemorative brick purchases. The brick plaza will be located near the trailhead and provides a unique way to support a valuable community resource while remembering significant events and people in your life.

Grin & Bear It 5K Run/Walk Raises Nearly \$6,900 for Cass Regional Patients

Cass Regional Medical Center Foundation hosted the tenth annual Grin & Bear It Run on Saturday, Sept. 28. The event grossed nearly \$6,900 for the Patient Assistance Fund, which is used to help Cass Regional patients in need with expenses such as transportation, medication, therapy and medical supplies.

Sponsors of the event included Country Club Bank; Foxwood Springs; Serenity Care Hospice; Sherwood Community Bank; CPSK Insurance Services; Robert Prettyman and Carl Pearcy; Troutt, Beeman & Co.; A World of Smiles; Harrisonville Family Medicine; and Steve Croy – State Farm Insurance.

The Grin & Bear It Run is held each year in memory of Cara Roberts, and the event began with a moment of silence in her honor.

The overall male and female winners were Kevin Heinrich of Raymore and Esmeralda Chavez of Harrisonville, who finished with times of 21:14 and 25:47, respectively. Heinrich and Chavez, pictured below, each received a commemorative stuffed bear, and medals were awarded to the top three finishers in each age group.

Following the 5K, participants were treated to breakfast catered by Chris Kurzweil of Kurzweils' Country Meats. Free health screenings were also offered.

Several area businesses also lent their support to the Grin & Bear It Run, including Harrisonville Community Center, Family Center Farm & Home, and Sonic Drive-In of Harrisonville. The Missouri State Highway Patrol provided traffic control for the event.





Chavez, Johns Named Co-Recipients of Jan Perry Scholarship



Briseida Chavez and **Terry Johns, RN**, have been named co-recipients of the fall 2019 Jan Perry Scholarship for Cass Regional employees. Each will receive a \$1,000 award, which will be paid directly to their respective educational institutions.

Chavez, of Harrisonville, Missouri, works in the dietary department at Cass Regional, and is pursuing a nursing degree at Metropolitan Community College.

Johns, of Adrian, Missouri, is the manager of the

cardiac rehab department at Cass Regional. She is pursuing a bachelor's degree in nursing at Chamberlain University.

The scholarship program was established in 2002 by the late Jan Perry of Harrisonville (pictured above). Jan, who was member of the Cass Regional Auxiliary, was motivated by the gratitude she felt for the nurses who cared for her throughout her battle with cancer. She initially funded the scholarship by putting back a little of her grocery money each week until she had saved \$1,000. After her death in 2007, her husband, Wirt, made a donation to expand Jan's scholarship program to two \$2,000 annual scholarships. Selection for the award is based on financial need and career goals.

Alma Brown Scholarship

The Alma Brown Scholarship was established in 2013 with a bequest from Alma Brown of Harrisonville. This \$1,000 scholarship is offered once a year.

Wanda Brown Scholarship

The Wanda Brown Scholarship was established in 1999 with a gift from Wanda A. Brown. This \$1,000 scholarship is offered once a year.

Elvin S. Douglas, Jr., Scholarshipw

The Elvin S. Douglas, Jr., Scholarship was established by friends and colleagues to honor Mr. Douglas' 25 years of service on the hospital board. This variable scholarship is offered once a year.

Geraldine Kidd Scholarship

The Geraldine Kidd Scholarship was established by colleagues, family and friends in memory of "Gerri" Kidd, who was an LPN for over 20 years at Cass Regional. This variable scholarship is offered once a year.

Dr. Harold E. Kirsch Memorial Scholarship

The Dr. Harold E. Kirsch Memorial Scholarship was established in 2003 with a bequest from Dr. Kirsch's widow, Evelyn. This variable scholarship is offered twice a year.

Dr. Gail G. Kroenke Memorial Scholarship

The Dr. Gail G. Kroenke Memorial Scholarship was established with gifts given in memory of Gail G. Kroenke, DVM. This \$500 scholarship is offered once a year.

Jan Perry Scholarship

The Jan Perry Scholarship was established in 2002 by the late Jan Perry, who was a member of the Cass Regional Auxiliary, and her husband, Wirt. This \$2,000 scholarship is awarded twice a year.

Attendees shopped for their fall favorites, some of which were donated by community partners.
