



COVID-19 Vaccine Information

Cass Regional Medical Center is committed to the safety of the communities we serve by working to end the pandemic. We encourage those who currently qualify to receive a **FREE** COVID-19 vaccine. COVID-19 can have serious, life-threatening complications, and there is no way to know how COVID-19 will affect you. And if you get sick, you could spread the disease to friends, family, and others around you.

All currently available vaccines in the US have been shown to be safe and effective at preventing COVID-19 and can help keep you from getting seriously ill if you get COVID-19, including the variant strains. COVID-19 vaccines teach our immune systems how to recognize and fight the virus that causes COVID-19. It typically takes two weeks after vaccination for the body to build protection (immunity) against the virus that causes COVID-19.

You should get vaccinated regardless of whether you already had COVID-19. Studies have shown that vaccination provides a strong boost in protection in people who have recovered from COVID-19. Safety measures such as staying 6 feet apart from others, avoiding crowds and poorly ventilated spaces, and washing your hands often should continue to be practiced.

Anyone in the US who meets the following age requirements qualifies for a COVID-19 vaccine: 12 and over for Pfizer and 18 and over for Moderna and Johnson & Johnson. Below is a list of local businesses where you can obtain a COVID-19 vaccine:
