You have been scheduled for a Gallbladder Ultrasound.

This is an exam using sound waves to clarify details of your gallbladder. You will be asked to lie down on a cart. An acoustic gel will be applied to the skin. A small hand held instrument called a transducer will be placed on the skin and slowly passed over the area to be examined. Several pictures will be taken for the radiologist to interpret.

Please follow the following instructions to prepare for the exam.

- 1. Have a fat free supper the night before the exam. (NO meats or dairy products). Dry toast or jello are good.
- 2. Do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night before the exam.
 - Please bring your insurance, Medicare, or Medicaid cards with you. To ensure
 accurate billing, the Admitting staff will need to copy these each time you come
 to CGH Medical Center for service.
 - Check with your insurance company to see if the exam/test ordered requires precertification or a second opinion.
 - Report to the Admitting department 15 minutes prior to your appointment to allow time for your registration.
