Blood Facts

- The American Red Cross only accepts blood from volunteer blood donors.
- Every two seconds, someone in the US needs a blood transfusion.
- Your whole blood donation may help save as many as three lives.
- One out of 10 people admitted to the hospital needs blood.
- Nearly 5 million people need blood transfusions each year.
- Blood is needed by cancer patients, people with blood disorders or diseases, premature babies, transplant recipients, trauma and accident victims, and to treat people with other serious diseases and conditions.
- People 65 years or older account for 13 percent of the population, but use about 50 percent of all whole blood and red cells transfused.

CGH Receives United Way Good Neighbor Award

CGH received the Good Neighbor award at the United Way of Whiteside County annual recognition luncheon on March 15. CGH employees raised \$33,261, along with a generous corporate gift for the 2016 campaign.

The overall goal for the campaign was \$720,000 and nearly 99 percent of that - \$710,648 was raised. Thanks to money raised outside the campaign, the
