Introducing CGH Heartbeat

CGH recently introduced a new, internal communication tool called the "CGH Heartbeat – Your Daily Dose of News & Numbers." This mini-website has daily updates and some parts of the current Communique, so you may see a shortened Communique newsletter in the future.

Two great organizations came together when the Sterling Rock Falls Clinic merged with CGH Medical Center in 2011. Virtually overnight, what had been two relatively small, tightly-knit organizations, has become today a much larger organization of about 1500 employees. As we continue to do great things together, we don't want to lose that closeness and family feeling. This is the primary purpose of a daily website. The hope is to emphasize and share our collective activities and better understand and know what's going on throughout the organization and bring us greater unity.

Just click on CGH Heartbeat daily through the weblink or through the link on LIFELINE to get a snapshot of our daily stats, birthdays, on-call schedules, and many other quick pieces of information to better communicate throughout CGH.


There are four sections – each with a different purpose:

1. The "Daily Stats" section will show statistics such as our hospital census, Ready Care appointments, clinic appointments, lab visits, ER visits, number of babies born, ambulance runs, and other statistics. The purpose is to gain a better understanding of the work we are collectively doing. It may help give us better empathy towards each other when a particular area has seen heavy volumes. Hopefully, this will result in a heightened level of kindness and compassion toward each another.

(Stats are only accessible internally, since the numbers link from Cerner. If you are outside the organization, you may access the site but daily stats will not appear.)

- The "Blog" section will be a venue for Dr. Steinke to share stories about CGH and topics pertinent to medicine in general.
- The "Forum" section is like a community bulletin board to send messages, ask questions, communicate between co-workers and departments. It's a great place to call out acts of kindness or recognize when people have done an especially great job.
- 4. The "For Sale" section is sort of like the classified section of a newspaper or a cork board to post notices of things that are for sale or those seeking to buy. It can also be a way to post general announcements.
