CGH Health Transformation Program



Have you thought about enrolling in the CGH Health Transformation Program (HTP) for 2019?

The Health Transformation Program (HTP) teaches participants how to lower blood pressure, control blood sugar, improve cholesterol numbers, and lose pounds and inches in the process. As in previous years, the 2019 program is open to CGH employees who have been employed at least 90 days and their family members. In addition, the 2019 program will be open to the public as well.

HTP is a one year commitment that includes classes every two weeks, individual counseling by a certified health coach, and quarterly lab work. Although there is a fee for the program, it is reimbursed for CGH employees if lab and class attendance requirements are met.

On Wednesday, December 19 **CGH Medical** Center introduced our updated and advanced capabilities in our all-new **Hybrid Operating** Room Suite with an open house from 3 to 6 p.m. Approximately 80 staff and members of the community attended the open house.

"The hybrid operating room at CGH is on the cutting edge of technology that is rarely found in organizations of our size, said Thomas King, DO, CGH Vascular Surgeon. "It shows our dedication to offering the best treatments for our patients with complex vascular problems to help them achieve the best outcomes."

A hybrid operating room combines a conventional operating room with an imaging system that supports high-quality interventional imaging (like a CT scan or X-ray) with complex open and minimally invasive surgeries. The hybrid operating room allows imaging to be done in a

minimally invasive way, but if needed, a more complex open surgery can proceed immediately.

"We are looking forward to utilizing the hybrid operating room to allow for a multi-disciplinary approach to surgery," added Young Song, DO, CGH Urologist. "We will continue providing minimally invasive procedures in surgery and urology that are safer and more efficient."
