### Dr. Manorama Hermon Retires After 36 Years

Manorama Hermon, MD, FAAP, celebrated her retirement with an open house on Thursday, December 20 at the CGH Rock Falls Medical Center. Dr. Hermon has been a Pediatrician in the area for 36 years and has been at the Rock Falls office since 1989.

"I have had the privilege of knowing three generations of families in my practice locally for 36 years," said Dr. Hermon.

Dr. Hermon attended Christian Medical College in

Vellore, India, and interned at West Suburban Hospital in Oak Park. She completed her residency in Pediatrics at Rush Presbyterian-St. Luke's Medical Center in Chicago. A Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics, Dr. Hermon is a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatrics and is a member of the Illinois State Medical Society. She is board certified by both the American Board of Pediatrics and the American Board of Integrative and Holistic Medicine. Dr. Hermon also has a special interest in treating pediatric allergy with sublingual immunotherapy.

Inspired to go into medicine by her grandfather, a family physician, at an early age, Dr. Hermon finished medical school at age 21. She observed that pediatricians make a difference for generations to come by helping children and parents make good lifestyle choices.

Dr. Hermon's husband, Surjit Hermon, was chief of Radiology at CGH Medical Center for many years and passed away in an accident 10 years ago. She really appreciates her three children's support and the support of the administration at CGH over all these years.

"I never could have done this without my nurses, Gayle Wright and Tracy Boyle," remarked Dr. Hermon. "This has been a great ride!"

CGH Health Transformation Program



Have you thought about enrolling in the CGH Health Transformation Program (HTP) for 2019?

The Health Transformation Program (HTP) teaches participants how to lower blood pressure, control blood sugar, improve cholesterol numbers, and lose pounds and inches in the process. As in previous years, the 2019 program is open to CGH employees who have been employed at least 90 days and their family members. In addition, the 2019 program will be open to the public

HTP is a one year commitment that includes classes every two weeks, individual counseling by a certified health coach, and quarterly lab work. Although there is a fee for the program, it is reimbursed for CGH employees if lab and class attendance requirements are met.
