CGH Health Foundation Annual Appeal Reception

More than 50 Tree of Life donors were recognized during the March 14 CGH Health Foundation Annual Appeal reception. Youth groups from throughout the Sauk Valley were also recognized for stepping up as the new philanthropists of tomorrow.

Foundation Chair Amy Downs expressed gratitude to the more than 100 contributors and friends present. "What a legacy we are continuing to build because of all of you." she said. "Our Tree of Life grove represents thousands of lives impacted. Your continued support is celebrated year in and year out. We are honored to be your chosen charity, grateful for the passion you show toward the wonderful projects you make happen."

Foundation Campaign General Chair Scott Wolber announced over \$361,000 had been raised toward the \$380,000 goal, with more gifts expected. He thanked the many volunteers who were vital to the success of the annual fund drive. Special mention was made of the late Pam Topper, who served as Business Division Chair during the campaign, until her unexpected death last August.

"It was an honor to serve with Pam." said Mr. Wolber. "She was such an ardent supporter of one of our newer projects – to raise awareness about women and heart disease. She shared her own story of dealing with heart disease during the campaign. We mourn her passing and extend our heartfelt thanks to her family for her efforts in behalf of the Foundation."

A combined total of \$10,666 was raised for the Foundation by the following youth groups: Amboy High School basketball and volleyball teams, Erie-Prophetstown volleyball and football teams, and St. Andrew's School. Foundation Executive Director Joan Hermes praised the students for working to benefit their communities by focusing on the needs of others. During the last 31 years, over \$10 million has been donated and invested right back into the community. Under-served children and adults have received free to low cost healthcare services. Wellness education centering on heart disease, stroke, cancer, diabetes and obesity has been a major focus. Scholarships have been awarded to several hundred college-bound students and capital items have been funded.

CGH Receives United Way Doyle-Huntley Award

CGH received the Doyle-Huntley award at the United Way of Whiteside County annual recognition luncheon on March 20. The CGH total pledge for 2018 is \$48,531.94. Of that total, \$16,000 is a corporate pledge and the rest is from employee payroll deductions.

The Doyle-Huntley award is given to a business with

a servant leadership mentality; being a long supporter; superior United Way engagement - including workplace campaign access to staff, filling leadership roles on the UW Board for many years, and participation in fundraisers outside the workplace campaign.

The overall goal for the campaign was \$775,000. The agency soared past the goal, raising an additional \$45,000 for a total of \$820,244. Money raised will help fund 33 agencies and programs that serve county residents.

New Lab Benefits for CGH Health Plan Participants

CGH is pleased to announce an additional health plan benefit that will positively affect employees with lab charges. Retroactive to January 1, 2019, lab charges have become a flat co-pay of \$25 per occurrence for individuals on the Base Plan and \$35 for individuals on the Value Plan. In order to receive this benefit, LABS MUST BE OBTAINED AT A CGH FACILITY!



How will this work?

The system is set up to reflect the co-pay similar to an office visit but won't be due at the time of service (it will be billed out like all other charges).

For example:

- If you see your physician and he/she orders a CBC, CMP, and Lipid, you will go have your labs drawn and you will pay \$25/\$35 (base/value).
- If you go back 2 weeks later and get a CMP drawn, you will pay \$25/\$35.
- If you get a TSH, Free T4 and Lipids 6 months later, you will pay \$25/\$35.

It is \$25/\$35 for each instance of lab draw no matter which labs are drawn. It is important to note that if the actual cost of the lab test is less than your co-pay, you will pay the lesser amount.

The change will be managed by UMR, and any questions about charges can be directed to the number on the back of your insurance card.

What about labs that I had done from January 1st until now?

Labs obtained from January 1, 2019 and onward will be handled with the co-pays as described above.

Why is CGH doing this?

We are always looking for ways to make CGH an even better place to work, and improving the health benefits we provide our employees on the CGH Plan is one aspect of that.

We are proud that this marks our third year without raising employee health premiums, while continuing to add additional benefits. This is very rare in today's environment, but want you all to know that you are an integral part of the CGH family.

We will continue to look for opportunities to improve our benefits, and we thank you for what you do each day!
