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CGH Medical Center Receives Prestigious Baby-Friendly Designation

Baby-Friendly USA recently announced that CGH Medical Center has received the prestigious designation as a Baby-Friendly birth facility as part of the Baby Friendly Hospitals Initiative. Based on the Ten Steps to Successful Breastfeeding, this international award is only given after a rigorous on-site survey, and recognizes birth facilities that offer breastfeeding mothers the information, confidence, and skills needed to successfully initiate and continue breastfeeding their babies.



CGH Medical Center has been working towards this designation since 2013, when the hospital and clinic staff began to make major practice changes that collectively support a mother breastfeeding.

"We are very proud to have achieved this Baby-Friendly Designation," said Jennifer Behrens, RN, CGH Birthing Center Assistant Manager. "Achieving the designation was a difficult process. It required education not only for anyone who cares for newborns, but also for those that care for pregnant or breastfeeding women. This included all hospital OB nurses, clinic nurses and medical assistants in OB, Pediatrics, and Family Practice. We also set up a program to educate patients prenatally on the benefits of breastfeeding, rooming in, and skin-to-skin contact after delivery, and we partnered with WIC in both Whiteside and Lee counties during the process to help ensure everyone is communicating the same message."

As part of this designation, CGH Medical Center will need to collect and maintain statistics related to Baby-Friendly USA's Ten Steps and will report on this information and its quality processes annually. The aim is to improve – through optimal feeding – the nutritional status, growth and development as well as the survival of infants and young children.

Baby-Friendly USA, Inc. is the U.S. authority for the implementation of the Baby-Friendly Hospital Initiative, a global program sponsored by the World Health Organization (WHO) and the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF). The initiative encourages and recognizes hospitals and birthing centers that offer an optimal level of care for breastfeeding mothers and their babies.

There are more than 20,000 designated Baby-Friendly hospitals and birth centers worldwide, and currently there are 574 active Baby-Friendly hospitals and birth centers in the United States.

Caring Fund Scholarship August 6 Deadline

The deadline for the CGH Caring Fund Scholarship for the upcoming fall semester is Tuesday, August 6. The CGH Caring Fund Scholarship was created in 2014 by the CGH Caring Fund Committee and is



funded 100% through CGH Medical Center employee contributions.

The scholarships are for any CGH Medical Center employees who are continuing their education through trade school/college/university and is meant to support those who are pursuing careers in any field. Full- and part-time students may apply.

Four \$500 scholarships are annually funded by the CGH Caring Fund, while two scholarships are awarded per semester.

Criteria for Application:

- Current full-time or part-time employee of CGH Medical Center or currently working on a PRN basis because of continuing education but has had full time status at CGH Medical Center in the last 12 months
- Proof of acceptance in an accredited program
- A brief profile of yourself emphasizing occupational goals (1 page or less)
- 1 letter of recommendation
- Short essay answering both of the following questions:

 (1) Why are you interested in seeking/building a career in your chosen field?
 (2) How will receiving this scholarship help you?

Procedure:

- Application must be submitted to: CGH Caring Fund, c/o Beth Warner 101 E. Miller Road, Sterling, IL 61081
- Applications will be accepted once per semester. Fall semester deadline will be August 6.
 Spring semester deadline will be December 10.
- 3. Monies will be disbursed directly to the school/college at the start of each semester upon receipt of completed registration documentation.
- 4. Yearly re-application is necessary for consideration to receive award.
- 5. Proof of enrollment must be presented for each semester before the award will be disbursed to the school.


They are here to help educate employees on the CGH Medical Center retirement plan, walk you through the enrollment process and online platform, and answer any financial and retirement questions you may have.
