

You have been scheduled for a Hysterosalpingiogram.

This exam must be done 8-10 days after the end of your menstrual cycle. Dye is introduced into the uterus to visualize fallopian tubes. Some cramping and discomfort may be experienced.

Please follow the following instructions to prepare for the exam:

- 1. You may eat and drink lightly before the exam.
- 2. Bring someone with you to drive you home.
- 3. You will be required to have a pregnancy test done the morning of your exam.
 - Please bring your insurance, Medicare, or Medicaid cards with you. To ensure accurate billing, the Admitting staff will need to copy these each time you come to CGH Medical Center for service.
 - Check with your insurance company to see if the exam/test ordered requires precertification or a second opinion.
 - Report to the Admitting department 15 minutes prior to your appointment to allow time for your registration.

 - Expect to receive a pre procedure phone call from our radiology department the day before your exam.

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
